OUR SUPER NOVA five paths off the inside down the backstretch in pursuit in close aim of the duel, tucked three to four wide into the turn and advanced to issue a challenge placed to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, got nudged by MY ROXY GIRL to the inside straightened away and held her lane denying the attempt to create space, dug in latching on the leader nearing the eighth pole, rallied to take command near the sixteenth marker outside a pair in close quarters to her inside and prevailed gamely on the wire being herded slightly late by MY ROXY GIRL in the last jumps. MY ROXY GIRL two to three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, attempted to ease outwards to nudge her way to a more open path in front against the aforementioned foe and was denied the move, dug in under a drive in a tight seam between foes from the eighth pole to the sixteenth marker, came under an off sided stick late herding out OUR SUPER NOVA to her outside in the final strides before getting bested at the finish. CASH OFFER coaxed from the gate, established the front and dueled from the two path with BERTRANDA to her outside while in hand, tucked inside half a mile from home, continued to knock heads through the turn getting put to coaxing five-sixteenths from home just beginning to shake off her early pace rival when confronted by OUR SUPER NOVA at that station, cut the corner into upper stretch, dug in scraping the paint under challenge from a pair to the outside holding command until headed nearing the sixteenth marker, then kept on clear for the show honors when shaken off by the top pair in the late stages. PUFFERY tossed her head when the latch was sprung and lunged at the start to the near side getting away last and conceding four to five lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased three then two wide from the tail of the field, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, improved position for the last major share. MAIDEN BEAUTY three to four wide in pursuit, got coaxed along at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch and weakened. BERTRANDA coaxed from the gate, dueled three then two wide with CASH OFFER to her inside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths and was shaken off nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch and tired.

CAPTAIN BOMBASTIC away a bit slow, remained stationed along the inside route, steadily advanced into contentoin during the run around the bend, maintained the momentum after fanning out into path five from upper stretch to the furlong grounds, out-fought a trio to his left to emerge at the sixteenth as the new leader, kept going well under a hard drive to edge away. FIRST DEPUTY at a considerable distance from off the inside throughout, was towards the four path in pursuit of the front runners on the turn, was about as wide challenging in earnest at the three-sixteenths pole, grabbed a slim lead by the beginning of the final furlong, was himself headed by the winner a sixteenth down the road, stayed on willingness to preserve the place. HELLBENDER gained the advantage shortly after the start, got guided onto the inside route, was being hand urged fighting off the pressure coming from a well-rated GO RUDY GO out in the two path, got set down spinning into the lane, was tested to the extreme in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, yielded reluctantly a sixteenth later, put up some fight afterwards before weakening from the sixteenth pole onward. DANGEROUS EDGE was towards the back in what was a tightly-bunched group right after the start, stalked the pace strung out four to five wide, the widest of all, on the turn, got sent out into path six during the stretch run, went fairly evenly late and had to settle for the final significant slice of the pot. GO RUDY GO firmly rated prompting the pace from the two path, got cued up at the three-sixteenths marker, bid for control during the ensuing furlong before backing away. SOMETHINGTOTELLYOU underwent a two wide pursuit, swung into the lane and lacked the needed response. UNRELENTING FORCE travelled three wide on the turn, was maneuvered out into path seven down the lane to no avail. OUR TROUBADOUR took up the chase from path three on the turn, got tipped slightly wider into the lane, gave way.

POWER PLAYER just off the inside in pursuit from near the rear, tucked inside half a mile from home, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, appeared to want to tip out and thought the better of it following the leader along the inside, tipped out a path near the eighth pole, closed well to issue a challenge roused through the final furlong taking command in the last jumps to prevail. QUARKY established the front and showed the way just off the inside in hand under some pressure from LONHTWIST to the outside, tucked inside half a mile from home, remained patiently handled until roused cutting the corner into upper stretch, dug in under a drive inching away to the eighth pole, came under late threat inside the final sixteenth and was caught in the final strides to the finish. DIGITAL FOOTPRINT just off the pace just off the inside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the show honors in a blanket finish to the wire. SWAMP RAT three to four wide in pursuit from near the rear, got coaxed along with five-sixteenths to run, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a belated kick outside to secure the last major share. EVERYONELOVESJAMES forwardly placed five then four wide in pursuit, got placed to coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, swung five wide for home, dug in under a drive and was outkicked. LONHTWIST prompted the pace four then three wide under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, weakened in the final furlong. THE BIG S two to three wide in pursuit, tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and made no headway. HALSTAAT six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn getting put to coaxing with five-sixteenths remaining, angled five wide for home, weakened in the stretch.

IMPERIAL HINT was put to a light hand ride after being bumped into by FIRENZE FIRE right after the start, had control established a sixteenth down the road and switched over to being rated, cut over to the inside, threw down the opening fractions on a loosely-contested lead, was allowed to wander into the two path spinning into the lane, had just departed the three-sixteenths marker when set down, as was FIRENZE FIRE, appeared to be the second to arrive at the eighth pole, albeit by an inch or two, as the twosome went at it in a spirited tussle, saw the nemeis came in ever so gradually but steadily from that juncture onward, having been put to some right side stick work, ventured onward with its path being shortened stride by stride, stood its ground in the shadow of the finish line going shoulder to shouder with FIRENZE FIRE, regained the top before the end and kept it. FIRENZE FIRE came inward after losing his footing springing from the startng gate, bumpng with the winner in addition to setting off the string of bumps that following that wound up involving all members of this quartet, got going and tucked into the two path, stayed within striking distance, although not latched on to the pacesetter, strode three to four wide into the lane, settled in at the three-sixteenths pole and was put to a drive, out-raced the top one to begin the final furlong leading but only by the barest of margin, proceeded to steady shift towards the inside leaving the furlong marker, resulting in the top one's path getting tightened in a steadfast manner, saw the maneuver thwarted in deep stretch with IMPERIAL HINT digging in with ultra gamenness to protect its turf, got nosed by that one and ultimately denied. BROWN BUCKEYE squeezed at the start, took up the chase from the two path, tipped one path farther off the rail for the stretch, went on to secure the show. AMERICAN POWER bumped right after the start, went on to save ground to no avail.
