GRAN ESTRENO (ARG), bumped at the start by COUNTRY FLAVOR, was given some prompting to gain a tracking position along the inside racing to the first turn, continued unhurried to the far turn, made steady progress inside foes nearing upper stretch to gain striking distance, altered course to the rail when lacking a path from which to challenge nearing midstretch, bid inside the pacesetter, then narrowly edged GIANT OAK in the final stages under firm right handed pressure. The latter, caught four deep racing into the first turn tracking just out of striking distance, was settled off foes entering the backstretch, advanced four deep on the second bend to gain striking distance three deep entering upper stretch, was bumped, then carried out a bit in late stages by MAD FLATTER and just failed to best the winner. MAD FLATTER moved clear from between foes into the first turn, held sway on a clear margin along the inside to upper stretch, drifted out leaving the furlong marker exchanging some contact with GIANT OAK and was narrowly outfinished by the top pair. ELUSIVE BEAT tracked just off the pacesetter racing three deep between foes into the first turn, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival as part of the second flight into the second bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. COUNTRY FLAVOR broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, shifted off the inside tracking the pacesetter into the backstretch, continued just off the inside into the far turn and steadily faded in the drive.
