The latter settled three deep tracking off the second flight early, angled to the inside racing through the backstretch, switched out three deep nearing upper stretch while being roused to advance and continued willingly to the end to challenge the winner nearing the wire while proving only second best. MISTER MARTI GRAS, held up avoiding tight quarters in the opening stages, continued unhurried near the inside racing to the far turn, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch and was finding his best stride late to gain terms with the top pair nearing the wire. FORDUBAI was rated along the inside stalking just off the pacesetter racing into the far turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch but had no closing response when called upon to advance. GIMMEADRINK stalked the pacesetter outside a rival under light rating racing to the far turn but came up empty racing into upper stretch. ONLY IN AMERICA angled inwards early impeding MISTER MARTI GRAS momentarily racing into the first turn, tracked off the second flight for a half and steadily faded
