A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year Olds 115 lbs. QUSHCHI (GB) came away well, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, raced off the rail on the second turn, continued towards the rear, was roused while three wide on the final turn, gained five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly into the final furlong, struck the front a sixteenth out then moved clear under continued left-hand encouragement. ANJAZ was well placed on the inside, saved ground while racing in the pocket behind the pacesetter, drafted behind the leader on the final turn, lacked room turning into the stretch, was asked near the three-sixteenths pole but still didn't have a seam to go through, lacked room into the final furlong, found a seam at that point, accelerated into second position and finished with good energy to get the place. MYSTICAL STAR was rated while off the inside, tracked the leader down the backstretch the final time, was asked on the final turn, chased into the stretch, made a bid in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, came out a bit under a left-handed whip while in front into the final furlong, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the show. ANGEL TERRACE was reserved inside through the first two turns, came out some on the backstretch the final time, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole while off the rail, was kept in by KISSABLE into upper stretch, bumped twice with that rival outside the furlong marker, bumped hard with that opponent while put in tighter at the eighth-pole then steadied, regained momentum after several strides and finished willingly but lost any chance. BEIJOCA galloped along at the rear while saving ground, was urged along while off the rail on the final turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved out some under a left-handed whip, was guided further to the outside near the furlong marker to avoid the checking KISSABLE and failed to rally. KISSABLE (IRE) raced off the rail on the first bend, came three wide into the stretch the first time, went three wide on the second turn, settled mid-field on the backstretch, was asked while three wide on the last turn, held her ground into upper stretch, keeping ANGEL TERRACE in during the process, bumped twice with that rival outside the furlong marker, bumped hard with that opponent at the eighth-pole then checked sharply and dropped out. TEAM went to the front, raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set a solid pace along the rail, was asked with a quarter-mile to go, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage before the furlong marker and gave way. (Rail at 9 Feet)
