1½ MILE. (Inner Turf) (2:29) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 Fasig-Tipton Waya S INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year Olds 117 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstakes over a mile in 2015 allowed 3 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstakes over a mile in 2014 allowed 5 lbs.; of a sweepstakes over a mile in 2015 allowed 7 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races over a mile allowed 9 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Gray or Roan Filly, (Apr), by Vespone (IRE) - Goldy Honor (FR) by Highest Honor (FR). Trainer Chad C. Brown. Bred by Henri Alex Pantall & Yvette Chabot (FR).

GOLDY ESPONY (FR) brushed the outside of the gate at the start, was hustled to the lead, set the pace while near the rail, controlled the tempo through the final turn, responded well when set down after straightening for the drive, was put to a right-handed whip, drew off into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under strong urging. **EASTERN BELLE (GB)** was taken in hand early, raced inside on the first turn, was reserved near the back while into the bit, bumped lightly with **EVIDENTLY** while in the two path on the second turn, moved to the outside down the backstretch, was asked while three wide on the final turn, swung five wide into the stretch, moved out under a drive near the three-sixteenths and finished willingly to just get the place. **WHITE ROSE** raced in the two path on the initial turn, settled on the outside, went around the second turn in the three path, continued outside down the backstretch, came under urging with three furlongs to run, went four wide on the final turn, came five wide into the stretch under a right-handed whip, was carried out some near the three-sixteenths and also finished willingly but missed the place. **EVIDENTLY** dropped back early, was rated on the inside near the back, bumped lightly with **EASTERN BELLE** on the second turn, continued towards the rear, raced in the two path early on the final turn, moved to the four path late on that bend, swung six wide into the stretch, shifted further out while under a drive and improved position to get the last spot in the superfecta. **KITTEN'S POINT** was reserved while racing the widest of the field in the three to four path, moved up passing the wire the first time, continued on the outside, was asked while three wide on the final turn, drifted out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch then was switched to a right-handed whip and was out-kicked then caught for the last spot in the superfecta. **QUEEN'S PARADE** was reserved while racing two to three wide, came under urging on the final turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, was carried out some near the three-sixteenths and also lacked the needed response. **HELLENISTIC** was in tight between horses at the start then angled in, raced under restraint near the back while two to three wide, was urged along on the final turn and failed to rally. **CAT'S CLAW** raced in the two path on the first turn, dropped to the inside turning into the stretch for the first time, saved ground on the second bend, dropped towards the rear of the field on the backstretch, was urged along while inside on the final turn and failed to threaten. **CHAT** brushed with a rival into the stretch for the first time, settled along the rail, was urged along while continuing to save ground on the final turn and came up empty. **DANZA CAVALLLO (FR)** moved up on the outside after the start, became very rank when taken in hand, had the rider try to tuck her in behind the leader down the stretch for the first time, had very limited success in getting her to settle as she continued to be quite rank, raced up close in the two path, finally leveled out some late on the backstretch, was urged along while inside on the final turn and tired. **NICE NUMBER** went three wide on the first turn, brushed with a rival into the stretch for the first time, settled towards the front, raced three wide on the second turn, continued in good striking range down the backstretch, was asked while in the two path on the final turn, dropped back into the stretch and stopped. (Rail at 9 Feet)
