BLAME was hustled up then angled to the rail heading into the clubhouse turn, settled in a good position down the backstretch, eased off the inside when advancing mid way on the final turn, surged between rivals to put a head in front a furlong out, kicked clear under solid hand urging and held sway. NO ADVANTAGE, taken to rate early while saving ground, continued inside into the lane, steadied when in a bit close in mid stretch, recovered soon after, shifted out late and finished up gamely. TIMBER RESERVE prompted the pace outside UNDERSTATEMENT, bid to near even terms leaving the three furlong marker, dueled on a short lead while four wide into the lane, was overtaken in mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. BULLSBAY was steadied between rivals nearing the backstretch, angled out five wide for the drive and closed belatedly. FLYING PRIVATE, within range while three wide, lodged a bid between rivals after a half mile, chased the dueling leaders four wide into the stretch then went evenly through the final furlong. EDGEWATER bobbed at the break, was taken wide around the first turn, moved prematurely while four wide mid way down the backstretch, dropped back off the pace leaving the far turn then lacked a solid stretch response. UNDERSTATEMENT cleared early, set a slow pace towards the inside, took pressure after a half mile, dueled from the three furlong pole, entered the lane two wide, continued to battled to mid stretch then weakened.
