FOREVER LIESL cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, had the winner close in after six furlongs, responded and opened back up after being roused, kept on past the furlong marker but could contain the winner through the final sixteenth. FRANK'S FOLLY was rated back from between rivals leaving the seven eighths pole, got by STAR SUPER while ridden wide leaving the far turn, gave hard chase into the lane but came up empty. STAR SUPER, three to four wide stalking the early pace, failed to kick on entering the far turn, faltered and was eased late.
