LIGHTS OF MEDINA was rated back off of FOREVER LIESL entering the first turn and angled out to stalk, came under pressure into the far turn and took closer aim, saw FOREVER LIESL kick back away after being put to pressure into the lane, came back under right handed encouragement nearing the furlong grounds, had her rider switch to the left stick and drew alongside a sixteenth from home, churned on and widened through the final fifty yards. FOREVER LIESL cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, had the winner close in after six furlongs, responded and opened back up after being roused, kept on past the furlong marker but could contain the winner through the final sixteenth. FRANK'S FOLLY was rated back from between rivals leaving the seven eighths pole, got by STAR SUPER while ridden wide leaving the far turn, gave hard chase into the lane but came up empty. STAR SUPER, three to four wide stalking the early pace, failed to kick on entering the far turn, faltered and was eased late.
