1 MILE. (1:32) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 Westchester S. (Grade III) FOR FOUR- YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights, 123 lbs. Non winners of \$120,000 in 2018-19 or two Graded Sweepstakes in 2019 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake in 2019 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance in 2019 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2019 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 20, 2019 with 23 Nominations. (Showery 64)

NICODEMUS assumed a forward position after making light contact with HOFFENHEIM right after the field had been sent on its way, kept watch on the front runners while stationed in the four path, ranged up late on the bend, stepped into the lane lightly hand urged, got called upon for much more in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, was hooked up in a duel with the winner for the final furlong, with SUNNY RIDGE a couple of paths closer to the rail lurking about dangerously, battled onward with gameness, getting the job done at the finish line. STAN THE MAN grabbed control and cut over to the inside route, was lightly coaxed picking the tempo on the backstretch, sailed along on a loosely-contested lead, was still leading by a comfortable margin spinning into the lane, got pounced upon by the winner a sixteenth down the road, igniting a spirited tussle, was determined to the end but wound up denied. SUNNY RIDGE away a length the tardiest, raced sluggishly during the initial stages, tracked the pace taking the inside route, flashed some interest as three-quarters was being completed, closed in well during the first half of the stretch run to pose a threat, ventured onward in a willing manner only to ultimately have to settle for the show. HOFFENHEIM brushed from both sides in the shadow of the starting gate, underwent a two wide pursuit, was set to a brisk hand ride for the run around the bend, slithered towards the path four early in the stretch and soon gave way. REALM in path two during the opening phases, was gradually maneuvered into path four once onto the turn, fanned out approximately six wide into the lane, had no rally. PRINCE LUCKY off the inside throughout, departed the backstretch strung out four wide, was already under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, made it into the stretch and folded. BANDUA lightly hip-checked shortly after the start, went into path two wide, was put to a prolonged drive approaching the half mile pole, failed to make any headway then backed away readily in the stretch.
