The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. SIR WHIMSEY was unhurried while outrun early, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch and rallied to grab the place prize. SPORTS TOWN argued the pace from the outside, stayed with the winner into the stretch but proved no match for that rival and faded in the final furlong. BRASS RUN was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. LAWRENCE THE ROMAN raced close up early while in hand, was angled to the outside on the first turn, chased the pace while three wide and was finished after the opening three quarters. PINK VIPER showed good speed outside, was caught four wide on the first turn, chased the pace for a half mile and tired.
