Purse \$750,000 *WHITNEY H.(GRADE I) A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$750 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box, \$4,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth. All Breeders' Cup nominated horses that break from the gate and finish from sixth through last place shall receive 2% of the advertised guaranteed purse as a participation award from Breeders' Cup Limited and NYRA will distribute 2% divided equally among all non Breeders' Cup nominated horses that finish from sixth through last place. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 14, 2007 with 23 Nominations. (Clear 76)

LAWYER RON stalked the pace while three wide along the backstretch, closed the gap from outside midway on the turn, charged past WANDERIN BOY to take command leaving the furlong marker then drew away with authority under brisk right hand urging. WANDERIN BOY sprinted clear on the first turn, set a rapid pace while being pressured along the backstretch, continued on the front while saving ground on the turn, dug in when challenged in upper stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner in midstretch and held well under strong encouragement to best the others. DIAMOND STRIPES raced in midpack while three wide for six furlongs, gained a bit while four wide leaving the turn, and continued on willingly to gain a share. FAIRBANKS pressed the pace in the two path into upper stretch and weakened from his early efforts. DRY MARTINI was unhurried while between horses along the backstretch, advanced five wide on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. MAGNA GRADUATE saved ground for a good portion on the way and lacked the needed response when called upon. FLASHY BULL steadied on the first turn, saved ground to the turn, split rivals entering the stretch and finished evenly. BRASS HAT raced well back along the inside, swung seven wide at the quarter pole and lacked a further response. PAPI CHULLO saved ground to no avail. SUN KING steadied in traffic on the first turn and was never close thereafter. AWESOME TWIST angled in soon after the start, was never a factor.
