COMMENTATOR rushed up to gain a clear early advantage, raced uncontested on the lead for seven furlongs, opened a comfortable advantage in upper stretch and drew off while being kept to the task. STUDENT COUNCIL was outrun for a half, raced in traffic on the far turn, swung five wide nearing the quarter pole and closed late from outside to best the others. GRASSHOPPER settled just off the pace while four wide for six furlongs, raced within striking distance into upper stretch and gradually tired thereafter. NOTIONAL was bumped and angled to the rail soon after the start, steadied in traffic on the first turn, saved ground while rallying on the turn, made a run to reach contention in upper stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. RISING MOON raced between rivals for five furlongs, settled in midpack to the turn and lacked a strong closing response then was vanned off after the finish. MERCHANT MARINE steadied after being pinched back and bounced around at the start, steadied sharply on the first turn, raced well back for six furlongs and failed to threaten thereafter. SOLAR FLARE (ARG) raced close up along the rail, took up chased after the winner on the turn and gave way in the stretch. A. P. ARROW was never a factor while racing wide. TIMBER RESERVE pressed the pace from outside and tired. TASTEYVILLE was bumped and pinched back at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. COWTOWN CAT steadied and was bounced around at the start, steadied in traffic on the first turn then angled six wide then showed only brief speed.
