The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Selection of fourteen (14) invitees by Saturday, July 24. Acceptance to participate in the Whitney Invitational by Saturday, July 31. Any original invitee that declines to participate can be replaced by one from an alternate list. Alternate list and weight assignments by Sunday, August 1. Any horse that competes in both the Whitney Invitational and the Woodward will have their entry fee waived for the Woodward. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. BLAME brushed with QUALITY ROAD at the start, settled nicely on the inside, moved closer while under light urging on the far turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, swung four wide into the stretch, moved a bit further to the outside near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied on the far outside, had the rider lose his right rein near the furlong marker, quickly regained the aforementioned rein, drifted in while coming to QUALITY ROAD near the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. QUALITY ROAD came in slightly and brushed with BLAME at the start, went to the front, was well rated on an easy lead, waited for his cue while off the rail on the far turn, was asked to pick it up a bit nearing the quarter-pole, had the rider take two looks behind him in upper stretch, was set down passing the furlong marker, battled determinedly when challenged late but was denied. MUSKET MAN prompted the pace on the outside, came under light urging with a half-mile to run, chased four wide on the far turn, dropped to three wide near the quarter-pole, battled determinedly in the stretch, was carried inward late and was outfinished while well clear for the show. HAYNESFIELD was fractious in the gate, smashed opened the front of his stall prior to the start, was deemed fit to run, showed some early speed, was rated just off the pace while a bit rank, came under a ride while three wide on the far turn, dropped to the rail near the quarter-pole and gave way. MINE THAT BIRD was unhurried at the rear of the field while on the inside, saved ground on both turns and showed little. JARDIM (BRZ) was taken in hand while off heels early, raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved off the pace and faltered.
