FROSTED broke alertly, was taken in hand spinning onto the clubhouse turn, moved past the earliest pacesetter, that being UPSTART, with an equally-rated NOBLE BIRD positioned three wide following suit, gradually shifted over towards the inside proceeding down the backstretch, with the previously-named opponent doing likewise, showed the way throwing down splits that had some life to them, edged away from the closest pursuers, both now under some light urging after going six furlongs, sputtered out into the three path stepping into the stretch, drew out to his largest lead during the ensuing furlong, was put to a light drive in the final sixteenth to complete the score. COMFORT was forced to check in the shadow of the starting gate when bothered as UPSTART was angling to the rail, sat reserved in the two path, towards the back of the pack teamed up with the rail-skimming EL KABEIR, got set down for the drive and rallied for the place. UPSTART was gunned out of the gate, angled sharply to the rail, cutting over in front of the second place finisher and causing its pilot to check the mount, had both FROSTED and NOBLE BIRD range up soon after entering the turn one, got taken back, kept watch on them from the pocket all the way to the quarter pole, cut the corner into the lane, failed to keep up the winner then was outfinished for place honors. EFFINEX strung out three wide on both turns, headed home slighter wider, failed to rally into a stronger contending position from upper to midstretch, flattening out instead. NOBLE BIRD headed for the first turn three wide, accompanied the top one as they moved past UPSTART, shifted in a steadfast manner onto the two path making his way from the top of the backstretch to the half mile pole, began to fall back from the winner with a few strides left to the quarter pole, came into the lane and gave way. EL KABEIR rode the rail to the quarter pole, was put to a full drive travelling on the far turn, yet failed to gain ground, came three wide into the stretch and backed away.
