Bay Gelding, (F**ab**), by Bellamy Road - Rule One by Street Cry (IRE). Trainer Richard A. Violette, Jr.. Bred by Fred W. Hertrich III & John D. Fielding (NY).

DIVERSIFY was hustled to the lead, raced in the two path on the first turn, set the clear pace through strong fractions, extended the advantage late on the backstretch, drew off while inside to the two path on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch under a right-handed whip, responded well in the drive and proved much the best under strong urging. MIND YOUR BISCUITS was restless in the gate, brushed with a rival at the start, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled near the middle of the field, was ridden along while two then three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, pursued the winner under a strong hand ride, was put to the whip coming to the furlong marker and proved no match but finished willingly while drifting out closer to DISCREET LOVER late to hold the place. DISCREET LOVER saved ground on the first turn, was urged along while well off the pace on the backstretch, passed foes under a strong drive in the two path on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with good courage to safely secure the show. TAPWRIT raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased the winner while moving from the rail to the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under an all out drive and tired. GOOD SAMARITAN dropped well behind while inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was hard ridden in the three path early on the far turn then angled to the five path, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MCCRAKEN raced in the three path on the first turn, settled under some urging, was ridden along in the four path early on the far turn, dropped to the two path while well out of contention near the five-sixteenths, spun four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. BACKYARD HEAVEN went around the first turn in the three path, settled towards the front, was urged along late on the backstretch, came up empty in the four path on the far turn and retreated. DALMORE was hustled from the start, went around the first turn in the four path, chased the leader on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped. THIS RACE WAS RUN AFTER A FORTY-ONE MINUTE DELAY WHILE THE HORSES WERE IN THE PADDOCK DUE TO LIGHTNING IN THE AREA.
