PURE TACTICS stalked outside a rival then between horses, split foes into the stretch, came out and rallied under urging to get up three wide on the wire. WINNING PRIZE (ARG) angled in and set a pressured pace outside a rival, inched away and found the rail on the second turn, fought back along the fence in the stretch and continued gamely to the end. WILKINSON stalked off the rail then outside a rival into and on the second turn, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch, fought back between foes late and went willingly to the wire. GLOBAL VIEW chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished. KULIK LODGE angled in and prompted the pace inside, stalked along the rail on the second turn and weakened in the drive. FLAMBOYANT (FR) angled to the inside and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FOOTSTEPSINBRONZE (IRE) stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and did not rally. BACCALO (BRZ) settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival into the second turn and could not summon the necessary response. COUNTY LINEMAN chased inside then outside a rival on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. ZURI CHOP (FR) a bit slow to begin, settled inside, went outside a rival leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
