DANCE TO BRISTOL , angled in near the half mile pole, hugged the rail, gained the lead near the five sixteenths pole, raced gamely through the stretch and shifted out late. OFFICER'S HOLIDAY lacked speed, swung wide leaving the turn and passed tired horses. SPRING FLOWER , wide on the turn, angled in in upper stretch and gave way. LOVE CONTRACT set the pace outside DANCE TO BRISTOL, drifted wide entering the stretch then faltered. DANCING ANNA saved ground and dropped back.
