MOSCATO (GB) four wide in the clear early on, worked his way to the two path after jump six, jumped well to maintain position, came under urging after clearing the final flight advancing to take over command along the inside straightening away for home in the flat, dug in under threat to the furlong marker before repelling that rival and edging clear kept to task while establishing a course record. NEW MEMBER (IRE) tracked along the inside jumping well to maintain his position, had to alter around a fallen rider after jump five, took to the outside to be four deep after the final flight when put to encouragement, advanced well through the final turn in the flat bidding to latch on the aforementioned foe at the head of the stretch, got ultimately repelled in the final furlong while running on clear of the rest and second best. MUTASAAWY jumped late at the first two fences being taken in hand off the heels of the leader both times, raced three deep through most, came under coaxing after clearing the final fence, improved position in the flat to secure the show honors. LACHARES (IRE) tracked the leader two to three wide at times from afar albeit in closest pursuit, jumped well to maintain his position advancing into striking range, came under coaxing at the final fence, bid to take command midway on the final turn now in the flat, got displaced from command nearing the head of the stretch and weakened in the drive. SURPRISING SOUL along the inside early on, shifted to the three path after jump four jumping well to stay in range, came under urging after the final flight, tired in the flat. KENSINGTON COURT established the front and spurted away on the pace two deep, jumped awkward over fence five, came under urging at the final fence, the field now just off his hindquarters, got displaced midway on the final turn and tired in the flat. ZIO ELIO three deep in mid pack, jumped well to stay in range, was in tight off heels of a pair of rivals when he bobbled heavily possibly from clipping the hind heels of one of those foes, however that was not apparent, lost his footing and lost the rider, recovered inwards to keep his balance and slammed into NO WUNDER forcing the rider off that rival. NO WUNDER (GB) two deep in mid pack, got bumped solidly by the aforementioned foe as that rival recovered from a heavy bobble and lost the rider as a result. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run by the stands for the first time before the result stood and the race was declared official.
