SOLDAT one of only two fortunate horses at the break, showed good speed to assume a forward position, patiently staked the leader from the outside, being lightly urged along, continued to bide his time until coming to the three-eighths pole, ranged up while being asked for a bit more run, entered the stretch latched on to the pacesetter's hind quarter pole, took off after that one after being straightened away, and having now been fully roused, took charge soon afterwards, then maintained a safe winning margin while kept to intermittent encouragement. POWHATAN COUNTY bumped at the start, tracked the leader from the pocket, was called upon to pick up the pace just past the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide to do battle, could not up with the top one during the stretch run, but continued on with good courage to procure place honors. TYPHOON SLEW veered out sharply at the break, bumping with POWHATAN COUNTY and setting into motion a series of bumps that effected all but the outside pair, recovered in short order to take the early lead, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead towards the inside, with the rider applying rating tactics, felt some pressure for the initial time, approaching the quarter pole, was put to encouragement but yielded to the top one readily in upper stretch, weakened steadily thereafter and had to settle for show honors. AIR SUPPORT bumped at the start, sat reserved along the outside for nearly three-quarters, was asked for speed in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, but lacked the necessary stretch response. SILVER MEDALLION bumped at the start, lagged behind in the early going, in a well-strung out field, closed some of the gap by the time he fanned four wide into lane, but failed to muster up the needed kick. KID CURRY brushed at the start, came four wide into the stretch. GRIGIO was bumped at the start, took the inside route, angled four wide at the quarter pole, but could not make any headway on the frontrunners. MANCHURIAN HIGH knocked sideways at the break, was never in contention. SENSATIONAL SLAM forwardly placed after having escaped the rough start, raced three wide on the second turn, tired after going six furlongs. LOU BRISSIE bumped at the start, folded after completing three-quarters.
