STATE OF PLAY brushed with a rival at the start, went to the lead, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch, was challenged on the outside by OPTIMIZER, came under the whip near the eighth-pole and held gamely under pretty confident handling. OPTIMIZER was caught four wide on the first turn, raced towards the front while on the outside, was asked while three wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled on the outside of the winner, had the rider lose his whip inside the sixteenth-pole and missed. DULLAHAN was taken up early on the first turn then rated on the inside, continued to save ground while just off the pace, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the show. KNOCK ROCK was in tight between rivals entering the first turn, dropped to the rear of the field, was reserved at the back, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and improved position. SPLENDIFEROUS brushed with a rival at the start, jostled with TWO MONTHS RENT nearing the first turn, went three wide on that turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. CAPTAIN WEBB was taken in hand while eager along the hedge, continued eager and under a hold, raced towards the rear while continuing to save ground on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, raced under a drive and also lacked the needed response. FOX RULES was reserved while under a very snug hold, hesitated in traffic inside the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch, lacked room in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. SPORTSWRITER went three then two wide on the first turn, stalked the leader, chased on the far turn and gave way. TWO MONTHS RENT jostled with SPLENDIFEROUS nearing the first turn, was caught four wide on that turn, raced on the outside while under some restraint, was asked while four wide on the far turn and also failed to rally.
