STARTUP NATION out a couple of steps as the field was sent on its way, was pulled away from the nearest opponent before any contact could be made, took the inside route during the initial stages, got tipped off it entering the backstretch, was in the four path when let out a notch coming to the three-eighths pole, was put to much stronger encouragement and unleashed a bold move about a sixteenth later, turned for home in possession of the lead, lugged in slightly, leading the rider of the second place finisher to check, shook free during the ensuing furlong, extended the margin even more before getting geared down in the final strides. INTERNATIONAL STAR away without apparent mishap at the start, was strung out three wide on both turns, picked up interest during the last stages of the run around the far turn to arrive at the quarter pole a solid threat, got checked while in tight after the eventual winner wandered a bit closer towards the inside at that juncture, got going once more, failed to keep pace and had to settle for being second best. NUTTY FUTTY saved ground on the clubhouse turn, departed the backstretch from the two path, tipped one wider near the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top twosome down the lane. STRONG COFFEE settled into midpack after the start, was well reserved racing between rivals for most of the way around the far turn, remained on hold, caught in some traffic approaching the quarter pole, was maneuvered into the three path at the head of the stretch, traversed through the furlong grounds tightly hand urged, was closing in on another's heels when altering course towards the outside, past the eighth pole, held on well to earn the last major check. DESIGNED FOR WAR stumbled at the start, travelled three wide on the first turn, moved up to become primary pursuer nearing the end of the backstretch, undertook the task from the two path, got called upon, positioned between rivals, heading home, gave way. HOT TIN ROOF tucked early along the rail, left it to elude the now-fading former pacesetter midpoint on the far turn, fanned into the six path from upper to midstretch, made no headway. CREAKY CRICKET appeared a bit eager during the early going, settled down soon after spinning onto the backstretch, ranged up and took over the lead after the half had been completed, made it over to the rail by the half mile pole, argued to maintain the advantage being pressed by DESIGNED FOR WAR to its outside, came under much heavier pressure after three-quarters had been completed, succumbed to it before coming to the top of the lane and faltered. KUTUZOV set the initial splits from the inside, yielded readily after going a half and retreated. Following a Stewards' Inquiry and a claim of foul lodged by the rider of INTERNATIONAL STAR against the rider of STARTUP NATION alleging interference in the vicinity of the quarter pole, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
