

1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:413) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 With Anticipation S.FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and startingfees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 120 lbs. Non-winners of a race on the turf other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; all maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The NYRA reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the graded stakes committee. Closed Saturday August 22, 2015 with 17 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, Two-Year-Old races will be run at Seven Furlongs and races for Three-Year-Olds and Up will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.) Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Jan), by Scat Daddy - Miss Ocean City by Mineshaft. Trainer Todd A. Pletcher. Bred by Mike Connelly (KY).

After two delays, with the first being RUNAWAY KING getting loose and galloping all the way to the top of the lane before apprehended by the out rider followed afterwards by MONSTER BEA being backed out of his stall and having a saddle adjustment, AZAR was bumped from both sides once the field was released from the starting gate, took over the pocket when MONSTER BEA chose to leave it, was coaxed by the pilot keeping watch on the runner up and would continue to do so all the way to the quarter pole, was given its cue for the drive home, cut into the gap, altered course in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker, without missing a beat, and flashing strong late energy, went by NEXT SHARES with a few jumps to spare before the wire to prove best. NEXT SHARES brushed with SITE READ at the start, raced side by side with MONSTER BEA for a portion of the straight run leading up to the clubhouse turn before getting conceded the front by that opponent, responded kindly to the hold utilized by the rider setting the splits from the inside feeling some moderate pressure from the primary pursuer, arrived at the end of the second bend with several revved-up foes in hot pursuit and got switched over to encouragement himself, held on with good determination before getting collared in the shadow of the finish line. UNBRIDLED DADDY the only member of this sextet toally unscathed at the break, raced from off the inside throughout, tipped out of the two path shortly after spinning onto the backstretch, was briefly wider than SITE READ before amending plans and drafting behind that opponent heading for the half mile pole, was placed four wide after going three-quarters, asked for some run at this juncture, sputtered six wide into the stretch, resulting in some loss of ground and momentum, finished the race down the center of the course well enough to secure the show. SITE READ made light contact with the second place finisher at the start, was in the two path travelling on the first turn, was placed one path wider midpoint on the backstretch, had the rider ask the mount for a response before completing the run around the far turn, failed to muster up a solid enough offering. MONSTER BEA was bumped at the start, race alongside the eventual pacesetter being taken back, was placed in the two path afterwards, staked the pace for nearly six furlongs before giving way. RUNAWAY KING was bumped springing from the gate, raced in the two path between rivals beginning from the half mile pole, swung four wide into the stretch under a full drive, had no rally.
