WICKED STRONG away in good order, rated kindly taking the inside route during the initial stages, vacated the premises midway down the backstretch, was let out a notch soon after entering the far turn, got angled outward four wide and put to much stronger handling heading for the five-sixteenths marker, turned for home within striking distance and with good momentum, closed in readily during the ensuing furlong, wore down a trio of front runners in the late stages to take command, kicked away, kept to a drive. SAMRAAT was rated while loosely drafting behind the second place finisher, continued along on the same scenario until approaching the quarter pole, when asked to pick up the pace, altered course slightly to the outside a furlong later, took off in earnest, failed to keep up with the top one, but fought onward with good determination to claim the place. SOCIAL INCLUSION broke alertly, was three wide heading for the end of the homestretch, looped by the runner up and took over the two path during the initial stages of the run around the opening bend, raced side by side with SCHIVARELLI, well held as was the nemesis, moved by that rival nearing the midway point on the final turn, doing so under his own power, remained with none latched on for the next furlong, although now being lightly hand urged, entered the stretch and got asked for his best, gave it, had the winner snatch away the advantage with under a sixteenth to go, then got nipped for place honors.
