The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three- year-olds, 119 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Gr. I Race in 2006 allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Gr. II Race in 2006 or a Gr. I Race in 2005 allowed 5 lbs.; Of a Gr. III Race in 2006 or a Gr. II Race in 2005 allowed 7 lbs. (Note: Grades as recognized by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee.) (No Canadian Bred Allowance) Final entries to be made through the entry box no later than 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, September 14, 2006. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by payment of a non-refundable fee of \$20,000, which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$17,940 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. closed Wednesday, August 30, 2006 with 31 nominations.

BECRUX (ITY) raced midpack three-deep, angled upper stretch for the drive, gained command a sixteenth out then held REBEL REBEL (IRE) save under steady handling. REBEL REBEL (IRE), well back and in hand, was set down at the top of the stretch, rallied gamely but couldn't get by the winner. AD VALOREM raced off the pace between foes, came three-deep late turn and rallied determinedly. SWEET RETURN (GB) set a pressured pace in hand, gave way late turn, rebid at the top of the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. REMARKABLE NEWS (VEN) pressed the pace, gained the lead late turn, had command to near the final sixteenth and yielded. THERECOMESATIGER raced off the pace, saved ground and rallied inside. THREE VALLEYS, in contention between foes, launched his drive at the top of the stretch but evened out. DIAMOND GREEN (FR), well back early, closed four-wide late turn but never threatened. CAPTAIN KURT (NZ) raced midpack, closed outside rivals late turn, failed with an all out bid and flattened out. DALAVIN, in touch early, was all out late turn and tired. SHOAL WATER stalked along the rail, dropped back on the turn, lacked a closing response. VANDERLIN (GB), contentious early inside, gave way between foes on the turn and tired. BALLAST (IRE) showed brief speed, stalked on the turn and tired.
