**5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.012) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 WOODFORD S. PRESENTED BY KEENELAND SELECT (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$ 45,000 twice on the turf since April 5, allowed 2 lbs.; a graded stakes on the turf in 2013, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Woodford will be limited to twelve, with two also eligibles. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2012-2013 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A Keeneland trophy cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, September 18, 2013 with 29 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at the Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track. (Showery 82)

HALEOCK outrun early, raced off the inside on the turn, angled to the outside for the drive and closed fast to be clear. EXPECTING CASH reserved off the inside, angled out four wide leaving the turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. SPRING TO THE SKY forced the pace four wide, challenged in earnest late on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but weakened late. STORMOTHECENTURY with the leaders while between rivals, battled into the final furlong and weakened. GLOBAL POWER behind the pacemakers while three wide, lacked the needed closing bid. TOUR GUIDE bobbed at the start, was outrun to the stretch while off the inside, angled out and showed late interest. CONSOLE steadied in the initial furlong when in tight, recovered to be close up while off the inside but lacked a rally. ANCIL alternated for the lead three wide, held on to the stretch and tired. PIRATES VOW within striking distance inside, failed to respond in the stretch. GREAT MILLS vied for the lead inside, dropped back late on the turn then faded.
