PREMIUM TAP came away well, took position to the outside of pacesetter SECOND OF JUNE entering the first turn, pressed that rival while well in hand, responded when called upon turning for home, dug in determinedly outside and prevailed after a prolonged drive. SECOND OF JUNE broke running, was urged to the lead, set the pace under pressure from the winner, responded when confronted by that rival and fought it out gamely from the fence. SUN KING was outrun early, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out in upper stretch, responded to steady pressure and was going well at the finish. PAPI CHULLO raced close up along the inside, saved ground throughout, put in a run entering the stretch and faded in the final furlong. ANDROMEDA'S HERO was outrun early while racing wide, continued wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. WILD DESERT was outrun early, raced inside and offered no response when roused turning for home. FLOWER ALLEY raced in hand outside, was four wide throughout and came up empty when called on. FUNNY CIDE raced close up outside, chased the pace while three wide and was finished after three quarters. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER was steadied after the start, was taken back inside, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. SUAVE was steadied entering the first turn, raced outside thereafter, had no response when roused entering the second turn and tired in the stretch.
