QUALITY ROAD moved out entering the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, moved to the lead outside the three-eighths pole,

edged clear without being asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came under some hand urging in upper stretch, was given one strike of a right-handed whip near the eighth-pole, held a sizeable advantage into the final furlong, was given two cracks of a left-handed whip around the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under hand urging late. MYTHICAL POWER was hustled from the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside while just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn, continued to chase QUALITY ROAD while under a strong drive in upper stretch and proved no match while able to hold off TRANQUIL MANNER for the place. TRANQUIL MANNER went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was asked to pick it up outside the half-mile pole, went three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide inside the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly but missed the place. CONVOCATION bobbed ever so slightly at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. INDIAN DANCE lunged at the start and was off about two lengths slow, raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was ridden along on the far turn, shifted four wide inside the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ARCODORO was asked a bit to take the early lead, set the pace on the inside through reasonable fractions, lost the lead to QUALITY ROAD outside the three-eighths pole, dropped out while under urging near the five-sixteenths pole and faded. MINE THAT BIRD came away in good order, was hustled from the start then taken in hand nearing the first turn, raced just off the pace on the inside, came under urging with a half-mile to run, dropped back while hard ridden on the far turn and retreated.
