1 1/2 MILE. (1:463) STAKES. Purse \$750,000 Woodward S. Presented by NYRA Bets (Grade I) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$750 each which should accompany the nomination; \$5,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$6,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$11,250 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing time of entries. The guaranteed purse will be divided accordingly; \$400,000 to the winner, \$140,000 to second, \$75,000 to third, \$50,000 to fourth, \$30,000 to fifth, \$22,500 to sixth, \$17,500 to seventh and \$15,000 to eighth. Weights: Three year olds 119 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of two Grade One Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2018-19 allowed 2 lbs.; of one such race in 2018-19 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake in 2019 allowed 6 lbs. The Estate of Mrs. William Woodward, Sr. to add the Woodward Challenge Cup, to be won three times, not necessarily consecutively, by the same owner before becoming his or her property. The owner of the winner will also receive a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. PRESERVATIONIST broke in then bumped soundly with foes on both sides, rounded the first turn in the two path under restraint, was rated just off the pace, drafted in the two path on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, idled behind the leading trio while under urging in upper stretch, split foes to make a bid into the final furlong, gained the advantage in the final sixteenth and prevailed under good handling. BAL HARBOUR was fractious in the gate, bumped with rivals on both sides just after the start, rounded the first turn in the three path, stalked the pace on the outside of the leader, engaged that foe in the three path on the far turn, took the advantage under a drive into the stretch, battled determinedly with multiple foes into the final furlong, led gamely into the final sixteenth but was denied while able to get the place. YOSHIDA (JPN) bumped hard with opponents on both sides shortly after the start then was pinched back, traveled around the first turn in the two path, was unhurried near the back, picked up interest in the two path on the far turn, was roused while swinging four wide into the stretch, moved out around the three-sixteenths, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed well but missed while able to get the show. TOMS D'ETAT was restless in the gate after BAL HARBOUR became fractious, avoided the bumping incident to his inside after the start, tucked into the three path on the first turn, settled outside in the middle of the field, moved closer under coaxing in the five path on the far turn, rallied to make an outside bid in upper stretch, battled under a drive into the final sixteenth and was outfinished. MONGOLIAN GROOM bumped soundly with foes on both sides at the start, went around the first turn in the four path, settled in the front half of the field, chased in the four path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip, pursued the vanguard under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. WOODERSON was one of two to avoid the bumping incident to his inside after the start, went three then two wide under restraint on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, came under urging while dropping from the two path to the rail on the far turn, steadied when MR. BUFF wandered closer to the inside at the five-sixteenths then moved back to the two path, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. MR. BUFF broke out and bumped with a rival then was hustled to the lead, traveled around the first turn in the two path, showed the way down the backstretch through solid fractions, vied in mostly the two path on the far turn, teetered closer to the rail around the five-sixteenths, was asked outside the quarter-pole, lost the advantage into the stretch then dropped back under a drive and gave way. FOREWARNED bumped hard with rivals on both sides after the start then was squeezed back, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten.
