By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination. \$3,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$7,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided as follows \$275,000 to the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth, \$15,000 to fifth, \$10,000 to sixth with the remaining \$10,000 divided equally amongst remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2015-16 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter, 6 lbs.; of such a race, 8 lbs. Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by More Than Ready - Goodbye Stranger by Broad Brush. Trainer Dallas Stewart. Bred by Blackstone Farm LLC (PA).

TOM'S READY got away sluggishly, made it over towards the inside before reaching the conclusion of the backstretch, responded when asked and picked up speed noticeably approaching the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward under much stronger handling spinning three wide into the stretch, altered course of paths closer to the middle of the strip shortly afterwards, picked up ground readily on the front runners, was taken hold altering course a third and final time, in this instance into the four path, no doubt influenced by the second place finisher's wayward ways at this juncture, grabbed away the advantage in the final seventy yards and shook free, crossing the wire under a hard drive. FISH TRAPPE ROAD attained a forward position after the break, prompted the pacesetter three to four wide on the turn, challenged when ready as the field headed into the stretch and took over, drifted out steadily down the stretch, both from left handed stick work and even when none was being applied, got caught well past the sixteenth marker and had to settle for the place. STAR HILL pursued the pace from the three path on the turn, was under solid encouragement spinning three wide into the stretch, drew up to the runner up, initially drifted out before getting herded out by FISH TRAPPE ROAD in the final furlong and got fended off. SHARP AZTECA was solidly bumped right after the start, kept watch on the pace from a slight distance from off the rail, got called upon coming four wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response after departing the eighth pole. DIG DEEP came in sharply at the start, making contact with its next door neighbor, settled in the two path, took up the chase from between opponents on the turn, set foot into the stretch and had no rally. TALE OF S'AVALL squeezed at the start, saved ground on the turn and made no impact. SEYMOURINI three wide at the midway point on the turn, failed to menace. COUNTERFORCE in the two path and put to a drive soon after entering the turn, never reached a contending position. AWESOME GENT brushed at the break, was parked out five wide on the turn to no avail. MRAZEK three wide entering the turn, swung five wide exiting it, got steadied lugging in midlane and mustered up no interest thereafter. JUSTIN SQUARED came in leaving the starting gate, then came in much more after being fed a diet of right handed shots in short order right afterwards, gained the advantage, appeared keen proceeding down the backstretch, departed it two to three wide, vied to maintain control matched up with the runner up all throughout the journey around the bend, came under intensified pressure from that rival as they headed home, succumbed to it and backed away. IMPERIAL HINT strung out four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, gave way.
