STILL HAVING FUN away without apparent mishap, pursued the front runners from the three path on the turn, picked up interest angling six wide into the lane, closed in readily, took over in the final seventy yards and kicked clear. ENGAGE sat reserved two wide in midpack, picked it up when let out a notch coming up to the five-sixteenths marker, was under a drive getting maneuvered into path five during the first half of the stretch run, wore down the duelers inside the sixteenth pole to gain a short-lived and slim advantage, proved no match for the winner but had enough willingness left to garner the place. PROMISES FULFILLED gained control shortly after the start, cut over towards the inside, carved out the pace, spaced at a slight distance from off the rail, attended by WORLD OF TROUBLE to its outside, left the three-eighths pole head to head with that opponent and would continue on such terms until the wire, got caught a short distance beyond the sixteenth marker, but went on to win the battle for third. WORLD OF TROUBLE away forwardly placed, retained that position, vied for command two to three wide, drew on even terms with PROMISES FULLFILLED as the half was being completed, was put to stronger handling soon afterwards, continued as a team with the previously-mentioned foe down the lane, ultimately getting denied the show. BEAUTIFUL SHOT stepped onto the turn towards the two path, arrived at the end of the bend and was fanned out, winding upl about seven wide, made no headway in the final furlong. GIVEMEAMINIT brushed into the left side of the starting gate after tossing his head prior to the field being sent off and running, loped along in path two for over a half, spun to the outside entering the stretch, shifted into path eight in stages, gained some ground, but without having posed a threat. THE TABULATOR three wide onto the turn, was moved into path six exiting it, lacked the needed late response. STRIKE POWER parked out four wide on the turn, gave way. PURE SHOT set up in path two after the start, loosely drafted behind the runner up, got sent out into path four after stepping into the stretch, straightened away and quickly began to fall back. MADISON'S LUNA rode the rail, got roused at the five-sixteenths pole, made it into the stretch and faltered. AQUA BEL SAR lost its footing springing from the starting gate, was tucked along the inside soon afterwards, drifted three wide into lane having little left, then finished the journey to the finish line having been put to a protective hold.
