BRIGHT ONE broke alert to the early lead, would set all the pace racing well off the inside, kept in the five path to upper stretch gradually widened under a left handed whip. CIELO GOLD off slowly went unhurried saving ground through the backside, would find stride near the rail in upper stretch advancing quickly to claim a solid second best. MORE THAN REGAL taken back off a moderate pace was called to action gaining steadily to emerge a threat at mid track in upper stretch, failed to sustain the move giving even response as best of others. AH DAY laid close up following BRIGHT ONE through the backside, tried rival from the inside bidding all out near the three sixteenths pole, rebuffed in upper stretch would wear down late. LUXEMBOURG well placed stalked early sitting close up to the far turn, roused to bid there began to waver outside the three sixteenths pole, had little left in upper stretch. WANNA RUNNER sat just off BRIGHT ONE from the gate to the far turn, called on there made no headway on leader then flattened out four wide in upper stretch. CIRCLE THE WORLD bumped hard by REGENT SPIRIT at the break was hustled along the inside staying close through the backside, hung in while extended on the far turn would fold up at the top of the stretch. REGENT SPIRIT came in bumping CIRCLE THE WORLD at the break, raced evenly at mid pack before giving way in upper stretch. HIGH BLUES played no factor before tiring. CROCODILE TEARS was always outrun.
