BULLET GONE ASTRAY well placed stalking a pair of duelers saving ground down the backstretch, angled to the three path nearing the quarter pole, drew even turning for home, drove clear in mid stretch receiving left handed pressure, widened to the finish line being kept to task. SAVE THE DRAMA pressed the leader soon after the start, vied in a three way battle entering the stretch running between foes, proved no match for the winner in the final furlong but gamely won the battle for second. DERBY EXPRESS broke alertly taking a short early advantage, headed mid turn, dug in leaving the quarter pole, began to weaken with a furlong to go and was outfinished late missing second place. ALLPRIDE NO FACTS showed brief early speed, could not keep pace from mid turn, gave chase entering the stretch but gave way in upper stretch finishing well beaten. DADS DIVINE stumbled badly at the break causing the rider to lose his irons briefly, trailed throughout despite being hard ridden at the three eighths pole, failed to factor.
