1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (.00) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 **YELLOW RIBBON S.(GRADE 1)** FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$400 each if made on or before Thursday, September 21, 2006. Closed with 14. All horses shall pay \$4,000 additional to start with \$400,000 guaranteed, of which \$240,000 to the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth and \$8,000 to fifth. Three-Year-Olds: 120 lbs. Older: 123 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. or be divided. If the number exceeds fourteen (14), preference will be determined in the following order: First preference will be given to Graded or Group winners in 2006. Second preference will be given to those horses with the highest total earnings in 2006. Entry and supplemental fees will be refunded to all horses which fail to draw into the race. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 85)

WAIT A WHILE pulled her way along to stalk the pace outside a rival, went up outside foes into the clubhouse turn then tracked the leader on the backstretch, bid again outside that one on the second turn, took a short lead nearing the stretch and drew clear under strong handling. DANCING EDIE pulled a bit early on the lead outside a rival, was between horses into the first turn, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, dueled inside the winner on the second turn, was no match for that one in the stretch and just held second. THREE DEGREES (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, went between foes into and on the second turn, steadied briefly in tight a quarter mile out, came out some in the stretch and just missed the place. SOHGOL (IRE) settled outside a rival chasing the pace, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. BOND DEAL (IRE) chased a bit off the rail then inside, went between horses on the second turn, was in tight leaving that turn, angled inward for the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SINGALONG (GB) was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and second turn, entered the stretch a bit off the rail and also lacked the needed response. MOSCOW BURNING angled in and settled inside, steadied in tight leaving the second turn and did not rally. LIVE LIFE (FR) prompted the pace inside then stalked along the rail, took up in tight a quarter mile out, entered the stretch outside a rival and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run on the second turn but made no change when they ruled LIVE LIFE was the cause of her own trouble.
