MOBILE BAY settled inside BOLD CONQUEST off the early pace, shifted out while advancing on the far turn, came past the quarter pole four wide with aim on the leader, struck a narrow lead in upper stretch and dueled all the way to the wire to narrowly prevail under steady handling. PAIN AND MISERY raced near the leaders heading into the first turn and switched out three wide about the seven-eighths pole, pressed the pace up the backstretch, struck a narrow lead leaving the far turn, dueled inside through the stretch but just lost the nod. BOLD CONQUEST settled outside the eventual winner off the early pace, was ridden past the three-eighths pole entering the turn three then four wide, dropped back and shifted in from the four to the three path midway on that bend, kept on through the stretch to get show honors. INTERNATIONAL STAR was just a bit fractious in the gate and broke in slightly, moved willingly to the lead and shifted in entering the first turn, set the pace under pressure from outside rivals, weakened once headed leaving the far turn. WHERE'S THE MOON moved to the lead outside INTERNATIONAL STAR leaving the first turn to force the pace, continued to prompt from between runners up the backstretch, weakened on the second turn and through the stretch. STREAKS BRO settled at the rear, shifted in to save ground on the far turn, lacked room in mid- to late stretch before coming out a path but was too late.
