LAVENDER CHRISSIE entered the first turn outside rivals three wide then eagerly advanced between foes two to three wide to take up position tracking the pacesetter, was asked for more run past the three-eighths pole while appearing to labor, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch still hard-ridden, made steady progress on the leader, struck the front a sixteenth out and forged clear. CALAMITY KATE moved to the fore from the outset to set the pace, drifted out a bit leaving the far turn, was collared about the sixteenth pole but held the place. SWEET OPPORTUNITY settled toward the rear shifting to the rail, came out in upper stretch and gained show honors. NAOMI shifted in heading into the first turn, saved ground tracking the leader from inside, bid along the rail in upper stretch but could not sustain the effort and flattened out through the final furlong. TOSHA TALIFERO stalked the pacesetter outside the second group three to four wide, floated out a further path entering the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SCAT MEANS GO settled toward the rear switching outside a rival, continued off the inside and had no rally. NEVER ENDS was in touch early racing outside, dropped back heading up the backstretch, floated five wide leaving the quarter pole and had nothing for the stretch.
