

ALL-Ways Standard Edition Version 10.0 Installation Instructions

If you are a first time ALL-Ways user, you should download the Full Installation software (aw32v100.exe). If you are upgrading from a prior version of ALL-Ways, you should download the Upgrade software (aw32u100.exe). For current users, your ALL-Ways race database, history files and other configuration files will not be disturbed by installing either the upgrade or full installation. However, it is recommended that prior to any upgrade that the user backup and store the database files and history files as a safety precaution.

Installation Instructions:

Step 1: Download the Full (**aw32v100.exe**) or Upgrade (**aw32u100.exe**) installation file to your computer. (**See above**)

Step 2: Leave the Internet and close any programs that might be running in the background (including the ALL-Ways program). Navigate to the file you downloaded and execute it by double-clicking on the filename. If you do not remember where you downloaded the file, use Windows Explorer, the FIND option from your START button, or the MY COMPUTER icon on your Windows 95/98/ME/XP desktop to locate the file. Double-clicking on the installation file name will start the installation process.

Follow the prompts to complete the installation of the ALL-Ways program. Note: You may need to reboot your computer at some point during the installation. If this happens, once you reboot simply find the installation file again and double-click on it.

After the installation has completed you will have a program group with icons. To start ALL-Ways using Windows 95/98/ME/XP, click the START button in the lower-left corner of the desktop, choose PROGRAMS, select ALL-WAYS 10.0 SOFTWARE and then click on ALL-WAYS STANDARD 10.0.

You are now ready to begin handicapping! Be sure to download and read carefully the ALL-Ways online manual and/or order the manual from BRIS at 800-354-9206, ext. 223. Also other documentation will be loaded into your computer when Version 10.0 is installed. You can access these documents in the ALL-Ways program group.
