1st Race 6½ Furlongs Dirt

JENNIFERS DANCE SA 01/24/05 B FT 47.1 H
 Responded fairly well to the asking through the lane to finish in 47.2 and a final 1/4 in 24.3. Was doing well late. A decent drill.

2nd Race 6 Furlongs Dirt

JEWEL'S TIZZY SA 02/06/05 B+ FT 112.4 H
 Worked with FREE ROCKET. The opening 1/8 was in 12.3 as they went evenly down the backside and turning into the stretch. ROCKET hit the wire in 100.2. Was only coaxed along in deep stretch for a decent move. TIZZY went down to the 7/8 pole for a 3/4 time of 112.3 and responded nicely to a hand ride through that final part. The final 1/8 in 12.1. A good move.

SA 12/10/04 C+ FT 49.1 H
 Worked with BLUE CAY. Difficult to separate these two. They both went a 1/2 mile in 49.1 with both coming the final 1/8 in 12.4 under very very light asking. A fair work for both.

3rd Race 6½ Furlongs Turf

Prior to Last Race -----

ROYAL PLACE SA 01/14/05 B FT 101.2 H
 Worked with UNCLE DENNY. UNCLE was breezing throughout to go in 100.3 while never ever being let run. Went the final 1/4 in 24.2 and always holding his stablemate at bay. ROYAL a good workhorse himself was only lightly niggled at to stay even. You could tell at any point though that UNCLE could get away.

Prior to Last Race -----

ROYAL PRICE (GER) HOL 12/18/04 B FT 103.1 H
 Was always under a tight reign. Slow time of 103.0, but was breezing the entire way. Looked as if he could have done much better.

INDIAN COUNTRY SA 02/07/05 B FT 100.2 H
 Worked with SUNSHINENBEER. No pressure on either side of this drill to go in 100.3. SUNSHINE typically a good work horse and was never asked today to go the final 3/8 in 36.3 for both horses. Both were doing well late and were hard to separate.

Prior to Last Race -----
SAVONAROLA (GB) SA 01/19/05 C+ FT 104.3 H
 Left the pole extra extra slow. Appeared to be galloping down the backside and then finished under his own power while reaching out fairly well. Can't make much of this considering how slow he was early and under now pressure late. Will need to see more.

Prior to Last Race -----
ROJO TORO SA 12/06/04 B- FT 100.2 H
 Finished under light asking in 24.3 for the final 1/4. Needed help changing leads to get a final time of 100.3. Generally works well. Decent drill.

4th Race 5½ Furlongs Dirt

REPEATER TROOPER HOL 12/16/04 C- FT 49.4 HG
 Worked with CALIFORNIA DRIZZLE. 49.3 for DRIZZLE edging away from TROOPER getting lightly pushed on the neck. TROOPER was under good urging at the end to do a final 1/8 in 13.1. DRIZZLE slightly the best but both need to do better.

FINE ART SA 01/21/05 C- FT 101.3 HG
 Worked with GOLDSCHIEDER. These two left the gate together with GOLD having a bit more early speed and was asked late to get a relatively slow time from the gate in 49.4 and a final 1/8 in 13.1. He'll need to pick it up a bit. ART was worse than that to go 5/8 in 102.0 while being pushed on quite vigorously at the end. Didn't appear to be much with very little gallop out.

5th Race 6½ Furlongs Dirt

Prior to Last Race -----

ULLOA SA 01/22/05 C+ FT 37.4 H
 This one has descended down the class order in the afternoon, but looked ok this morning. Went in 37.4 under very light coaxing. An ok drill.

Prior to Last Race -----

MASHIKO SA 02/10/05 C+ FT 59.3 H
Worked with AWESOME LADY. They couldn't have been going any quicker down the backside while flying going head and head into the turn doing an opening 1/8 of 11.2. MASHIKO finished under a good hand ride to hit the wire in 59.4. LADY got the best of him late while under very light pressure to finish in 59.3. A decent move for LADY. If MASHIKO didn't go so hard early, might have finished a bit better.

SA 02/04/05 C+ FT 112.3 H
Worked with AWESOME LADY. These two good horses went head and head down the backside to get a final 3/8 in 36.4. LADY got a final time of 112.2 which was about a length the best at the end going extra extra easy to the wire. The boy just sat on him late. MASHIKO went in 112.3 while under a hand ride to stay with his stablemate, but still recorded a strong time. He could be tough if dropped a bit in the claiming ranks. LADY is sitting on a big race.

PRAGMATICO (ARG) SA 01/27/05 C+ FT 38.2 B
A lethargic drill in 38.1 under very light asking that final 1/16. Was reaching out fairly well at the end. An ok drill.

SA 01/17/05 C FT 37.0 H
37.1 was the final time going extra easy to the wire. Got a tap on the shoulder in the gallop out and didn't appear to gallop out all that well. Just an ok drill.

6th Race 6 Furlongs Dirt

WHITE PINE SA 02/13/05 B+ GD 100.0 HG
Worked with ICY ROUTE. PINE showed excellent speed from the gate early and quickly opened up about six lengths to go the first 3/8 in 33.4 without being asked and was lightly coaxed along through the end to finish in 59.1. Had blinkers on this morning and is definitely one to follow. ICY was no match for the mate in 50.4 after getting up after a 1/2 while being urged on the neck. Definitely needs to do better.

FOURTY WINKS MORE SA 02/14/05 B+ FT 113.4 HG
Worked with PROUD CHIEF, TIME AGAIN, and BOLD FLYER. They came from the gate as a group with FOURTY always being the best in this drill drawing out by several lengths at the end of the work to come the final 1/4 in 24.4 responding nicely to a hand ride. BOLD got the best of the other two slightly at the end while being lightly coaxed along at the end of the work to do a 12.4 final 1/8 and finished in 115.4. The other two were still head and head being urged at the conclusion of the work to finish in 116.0.

SA 02/07/05 B+ FT 47.1 HG
Worked with BOLD FLYER and TIME AGAIN. FOURTY definitely the best of this threesome while never under any pressure going easily the entire way from the

gate to finish in 47.1 and getting a final 1/4 in 24.3. A good 1/2. The other two stayed right along side, but both were being urged on the neck through the last part to record the same final times. Both were definitely second best.

SA 01/19/05 C+ FT 113.0 H
Worked with TEMPTING DATE. FOURTY no match for his stablemate this morning as TEMPTING roared on by down the stretch and cleared by several lengths to get a final time of 111.4. Went the final 3/8 in 36.3 for a very nice finish while under a hand ride. FOURTY was being pushed on more than his mate and was unable to stay with him. He finished in 113.1.

SA 01/13/05 B FT 102.3 H
Worked with TEMPTING DATE. Went a bit faster than given to get final times of 101.3. They broke off doing a 12.2 early then finished under hand rides to come the final 1/8 in 12.3. A decent drill for both.

SA 01/06/05 B WF 36.4 H
Worked with TEMPTING DATE. These two went head to head the entire way hitting the wire in 36.4. FOURTY appeared to be going the easier of the two While under no pressure at all. TEMPTING under light coaxing.

SA 12/27/04 B+ FT 100.0 H
Worked with TEMPTING DATE. FOURTY finished under a long tight reign to come the final 1/4 in 24.2 and a final time of 47.2. Very nice move. TEMPTING was lightly niggled at to come the final 1/4 in 24.3 and was unable to stay with better stablemate. Had a final time of 47.3. Still a decent drill, but FOURTY was definitely the best here.

SA 12/09/04 B FT 102.1 H
Worked with TEMPTING DATE. FOURTY WINKS MORE broke approximately 3 lengths behind TEMPTING and eased his way up to get even to the wire with a final time of 102.1. Had a final 1/4 in 25.0 without being asked. Definite improvement on FOURTY. TEMPTING was lightly coaxed along through the stretch to stay even. Decent drill for both.

TERRITORIAL SA 02/14/05 C+ FT 113.0 H
Worked with FELINE TACTICS. They were sent away from the pole in the early part of this work and were urged through the lane to come the final 1/4 in 24.4 and get a final time of 113.1. Decent time wise, but definitely asked to do it on each side. Ok.

Prior to Last Race -----
TERRITORIAL SA 12/26/04 B FT 102.0 B
Worked with JUDGE'S PEGASUS. TERRITORIAL notorious for working well and looked decent again this morning to get a final time of 101.4 and a final 1/4 in 24.4. PEGASUS just lightly niggled at to be even with TERRITORIAL throughout to also get a final 1/4 in 24.4. Nice drill for both.

Prior to Last Race -----

JOHNNY ICE HOL 12/11/04 B FT 48.3 HG
Worked with RIVER ISLAND. These two came from the gate together. JOHNNY always the best here to draw out by 5 at the conclusion getting a final 1/8 in 12.2 and a final time of 48.3. RIVER was being pushed on the neck at the end of his drill, but could not keep up with JOHNNY and needs to do better than this.

HOL 11/11/04 B- FT 101.3 H

Working with RIVER ISLAND. These two very difficult to separate. 101.3 with both of them hitting the wire together. Final 1/4 was in 24.3. Both of them were hand ridden to get there. Need to see more on both.

Prior to Last Race -----

HANDSOME MICHAEL K SA 01/15/05 C+ FT 116.0 H
116.1 for the final time finishing under light coaxing to go the final 1/4 in 25.2. He'll need to pick it up to do any good around here.

MOZE SA 01/24/05 B FT 47.2 HG
Worked with MS. GRIZZ and VERY CHIC. GRIZZ finished under a hand ride to come the final 1/4 in 25.0 and finished in 100.4. MOZE got the final 1/8 in 12.2 and a final time in 47.2 getting up after a 1/2. CHIC was asked with the hands late to get a final time in 48.0. He'll have to pick it up a bit.

SA 01/19/05 C+ FT 36.0 HG

Worked with VERY CHIC. These two came from the gate together to go in 36.3. Neither were serious and they were a bit slower than given. Would like to see them break a bit better and asked more in the morning. Just an ok drill.

MARSHAL LUCKY SA 02/13/05 C- GD 49.0 HG
Worked with VIDEO STARLET, SPLENDID GENIUS and PAVONA. They came from the gate together with LUCKY the first to drop back while being asked down the backside. VIDEO and PAVONA were the quickest of the group with PAVONA going easily on the outside of VIDEO doing splits of 22.1, 34.1, and 46.2 to edge away at the end. Much improved drill there and was the first time she showed anything at all. A much better time then given on PAVONA. VIDEO couldn't stay with his stablemate late being about a length behind while being lightly urged on the neck late with blinkers on to finish in 46.2. GENIUS tracked them about two lengths behind and got up after 3/8 to finish in 35.2 while being coaxed along lightly. LUCKY continued to drop back while being lightly urged to finish in 49.0, but really showed very little in this drill.

7th Race 6 Furlongs Dirt

Prior to Last Race -----

SINISTER G SA 12/02/04 B FT 100.2 H
Going the final 1/8 going extremely easily in 12.1 and finishing in 100.2. Reaching out well to the wire.

SIPHONIZER SA 01/17/05 B FT 50.4 H
Went a slow 1/2 in 51.1, but he wasn't asked to do any more than that doing it on his own power. Wasn't really doing anything. Just a fair drill.

RUSHIN' TO ALTAR SA 01/19/05 B+ FT 49.1 H
Continues to train well in the morning going today in 49.1 while breezing the entire way. Went the final 1/4 in 24.4. A nice drill and just waiting for him to show up in the afternoon.

SA 01/13/05 B+ FT 48.3 H

Went a 1/2 in 48.3 this morning going very easily and finished under a light hand ride. Came the final 1/4 in 24.3 and appeared to gallop out with more energy. A good drill.

SA 10/01/04 C FT 116.4 H

Stevens up; an unimpressive drill on the deepish track (25.1 final 1/4).

SA 09/25/04 C+ FT 101.1 H

Stevens up, went in 12.3 early and finished ok to go in 100.3+ (48+ final 1/4, track very fast), ok?

Prior to Last Race -----

RUSHIN' TO ALTAR DMR 08/28/04 A- FT 124.4 H
Timed from the 6f pole; slow start in 13+, picked it up though in 24.4 and went evenly to the 1/4 pole in 48.4+, then finished in a very nice rally to reach the wire in 112.2 (23.2+ final 1/4, track fast); working very well lately!

DMR 08/21/04 A FT 111.4 H

Timed from the 5f pole; went well early under some restraint in 13 flat, reached the 1/4 pole in 36.4+ and was under the whip late in 59.4, went on to the 7f pole in 111.1 and got up at the 6f pole in 123.3+; has a clumsy way of traveling but turned in an excellent drill. Went the final 6f furlongs (excluding that first 13 1/8th) in 23.4+ 46.4 58.1 110.3+ (from the half mile pole to the 6f pole, track fast), impressive!

DMR 08/15/04 C+ FT 100.4 H

Finished fairly well coming the final 3f in 23.4 36 flat, had a clumsy way of traveling though (track not really fast), a fair drill.

DMR 08/08/04 C FT 48.4 H

Came through the lane racing erratically, not looking that good (track super fast).

8th Race 6½ Furlongs Turf

RIDE AND SHINE SA 02/05/05 C+ FT 47.3 H
Worked with SAN REMY (IRE). REMY was the best of his stablemate this morning and showed a bit of improvement to come the final 1/4 in 24.3 and a final time of 47.1. SHINE typically works well was being asked through the lane quite vigorously to get a final time of 47.3.

Prior to Last Race -----

HEMET THOUGHT **HOL 12/18/04 B+** FT 112.0H

This good worker put in another sharp drill this morning going in 112.1 and a final 1/4 in 24.2. Typical drill for him from a very fast working barn. Still must respect based on the time and splits.

9th Race **1 Mile** **Dirt**

Prior to Last Race -----

CASHISGOODASMONEY **SA 12/27/04 B** FT 51.3H

This one was working with the dogs up on the main track to go in 51.1. Was breezing the entire way and was never let run at any point. Finished with lots of run left. A good 1/2 mile regardless of the slow time.

Prior to Last Race -----

SOUPY **SA 01/13/05 B-** FT 48.4H

Worked with REDMEANS GO. These two went head and head throughout to go in 49.0 to the wire. Both were under pretty good hand rides to come the final 1/8 in 12.3. REDMEANS GO needed a bit of help changing leads. Was difficult to separate the two. Fair at best.

LUCKY LEO **SA 02/09/05 B** FT 112.2H

Worked with CRAFTY VALUE. They recorded the best 3/4 of the morning to go in 112.4 which is just slightly slower than given. Still both were strong drills going the final 3/8 in 37.1 while under a hand ride going head and head to the wire. Hard to separate.
