Horse / Projected Next Start	Date	Race	Trip Notes
ALPHABET KISSES 3-, MAIDEN, SPRINT	3/28/04	1	Firster can run. Alphabet Soup filly lacked gate speed, up to third on the inside while racing green and taking dirt, angled three-wide on turn, steady finish. She'll move up a ton next time for Marty Jones.
CLEVER FANCY 3-, MAIDEN, ROUTE, TURF	3/28/04	9	Saved ground and did nothing. Biancone may be setting this one up for a Keeneland wagering coup. Simulcast bettors beware.
NOCHES DE ROSA (CHI) 4+, W, CLASFD ALW, ROUTE, TURF, LONGER	3/28/04	2	In for a prep, raced third or fourth on the rail, didn't kick with leaders, but finished well. One mile too short for her.
RIVER LIGHTS 3-, W, \$62.5K, ROUTE, TURF	3/25/04	5	Settled in the clear, good spot down backside, waited for room at 1/4, cut corner into stretch, was blocked and steadied behind winner in mid-stretch, then angled out and finished okay. He might have been right there with clean trip.
SKY DREAMS 3-, MDN, \$32K, ROUTE	3/26/04	8	Bobbled soon after the start and lost her action, dropped back, rallied far turn, lost her punch. Without the bobble soon after the break, she's in it all the way.
STARSPELL 4+, MDN, \$25K, SPRINT	3/25/04	6	Settled from between runners, cut corner into lane, was rallying inside winner through the lane, then was forced to take up when hole closed at 1/16th. He would have been right there with a clear run.
WATCHEM SMOKEY 4+, W STAKES, SPRINT	3/28/04	8	Would have won the race without the spill. Settled back in fourth, was launching his bid and just picking up steam on the turn when he fell over the broken down horse. The way the race unfolded - fast early, slow late - he almost would have had to win.
