For the last two years, *Owner-Breeder International* has presented a special feature, analyzing the new stallions for the upcoming breeding season, but with a view to their pedigrees and what they might cross best with. In previous issues, this has been combined with the Freshman Sire Selections, but this year, the topics have been split. Never fear! The 2002 Freshman Sire Selections will appear in the first issue for next year.

While the industry is experiencing a sense of tentativeness over the market and world events, the stallions at the top of our industry seem to be unshaken. If anything, their value continues to increase. Storm Cat now demands a stud fee of \$500,000, A.P. Indy

\$135,000, the same as Ashford barn-mate Fusaichi Pegasus, both of which entered stud in 2001.

End of the trail

Unfortunately, we lost two of the best this past November, when Unbridled succumbed to a chronic colic situation at the age of 14, and Nureyev to a cancer in the foot at the age of 24. The death of Unbridled was extremely premature. A champion on the track, he was taking the Mr. Prospector male line into a whole new dimension as a classic-level sire. At least we have his final crop *in utero*, foals of 2002, which

season. These included the serious international sire Irish River, as well as Carr de Naskra, Groovy, Canadian sire Son of Briartic, and Maryland staples Horatius and Shelter Half.

In 2001, we also regained something we thought we had lost. Seattle Slew recovered from delicate neck surgery to cover a full book of mares with the same efficiency he had shown before the nightmare spring of 2000, when he began to show signs of ataxia and loss of fertility. In 2002, he will be 28, and all signs are "Go" for him to return to action in the spring.

Slew is the oldest stallion of prominence still covering mares. In 2002, Spectacular Bid and Clever Trick will be 26. Danzig and Kris S. will be 25. Lord Avie, Miswaki, Well Decorated and Wolf Power will be 24. Silver Hawk will be 23.

Change of life

There have been a few interesting moves for the new breeding season as well. Three sires return from Japan, Hennessy,

Geri, and Housebuster. Hennessy, who stood the 2001 season in Japan, returns to Ashford Stud and was originally advertised with a 2002 fee of \$20,000. This quickly jumped to \$45,000 following that winning move by Johannesburg in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1). For a young son of Storm Cat with the best ahead of him, this still looks like a good value.

Geri returns after two seasons in Japan and shifts, with the rest of the former Brookside stallions (Theatrical and Jade

\$300,000, Kingmambo \$200,000, and while the fees for Danzig, Seattle Slew and Seeking the Gold are politely listed as "Private," they are orbiting up there in the same price range.

There are a few others whose stud fees are \$100,000 or over, including Saint Ballado, Rahy, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Unbridled's Song and Theatrical. Among the new young Turks, Point Given leads the way with this new sire crop, starting off with a stud fee of \$125,000. Giant's Causeway stands his first season in North America, his second overall, for

will race in 2004.

Anything we had from Nureyev was a gift, following fertility problems and what should have been a fatal hock injury early in his stud career. His final crop, currently *in utero*, will be minimal, since only two of his nine mares were confirmed in foal. Still he managed to leave a long and stellar legacy of brilliant runners.

Several top stallions have been pensioned following the 2001 breeding

Hunter) to Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Kentucky. His fee will be \$5,000, which for a multiple grade one-winning son of Theatrical seems like a pretty good deal. The champion sprinter and proven sire Housebuster returns from Japan to stand at Blue Ridge Farm in Virginia for a \$7,500 stud fee. To balance the exchange, this year's freshman sire Boston Harbor and the newly retired Captain Steve are going to stand in Japan.

New York is picking up a few top proven sires from Kentucky, primarily Phone Trick and American Chance. Phone Trick, the ultra-proven son of Clever Trick moves from Walmac International to Milfer Farm. American Chance, the best sire son of New York's late leading sire Cure the Blues, moves from the Vinery to Questroyal Stud. New York is also getting the good Afleet son Rizzi, who moves from the Florida division of Sez Who Thoroughbreds to their new New York division, and will stand for a fee of \$10,000.

Outward bound

The reshuffling in Kentucky is also helping out some other regional programs. Caller I. D., a son of Phone Trick, moves to New Jersey, as does Numerous, both to Walnford Stud for the 2001 season. Dusty Screen and Judge T C are going to Pennsylvania. Florida breeders will now have easy access to Golden Gear, Cobra King and Intidab. Comic Strip and Dumaani are headed for California. Gold Legend and Kayrawan move to Texas.

Adena Springs North in Canada is also sending Florida-breds Birdonthewire and Friendly Lover back to the southern division in Florida where their pedigrees (by Proud Birdie and Cutlass respectively) will be most appreciated.

There are also a few stallions moving out of the country altogether. Allied Forces moves to England, Elnadim to Ireland. Torrential has joined the former Louisiana resident Spend A Buck in Brazil. Party Manners went to Venezuela.

It's interesting to see two proven sires moving to Kentucky. Grade one winner Matty G began his career in Florida and moved to California before sire success caught up with him this year. He now stands at Darby Dan Farm. After a brief stay in Illinois, Little Missouri, sire of the champion Prairie Bayou, returns to Kentucky to stand at Spendthrift, joining much of the crew he used to know during his days at Dixiana Farm.

It takes a lot for a stallion to be courted by Kentucky stud managers. For a move like Matty G, it's the promise of a hot freshman sire who has the race record and pedigree that indicates he's not just a fluke. For an unproven stud prospect, race record and pedigree are all they have to go on. Since the package rarely owns both (except for phenoms like Fusaichi Pegasus and Lemon Drop Kid) the Kentucky farms must often decide which they feel is more important.

Time will tell whether outstanding performers like Skip Away and Silver Charm can rewrite their less-than-perfect pedigrees. Time will tell whether pedigree alone can pull up the seemingly endless number of lesser-raced sons of legendary sires that are retired to stud each year.

New sires for 2002

Our focus in this issue will be those sparkling new stallions entering stud in North America and Europe in the spring of 2002. This batch of new sires represents a benchmark year of sorts, because it's been a long time since we've had so few new young sires joining the stallion ranks. In previous seasons, the list of newcomers has been a lengthy one, but this year's roster seems abbreviated. Is this a reflection of an industry's need to reduce risk in the extremely volatile stallion market?

New sires in the regional markets (outside of Florida and California) are even harder to come by. Disco Rico and

Mojave Moon make up the new line up in Maryland. New York gets City Zip and Radio Star, although the Empire State more than made up for this light showing with the arrival of the proven sires Phone Trick and American Chance. Texas, admittedly over inundated with stallions per capita, only took in one new one this year.

Yes, it's going to be an interesting breeding season. Kentucky breeders are wondering if they'll be struck again by Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome, and many regional breeders are choosing to steer well clear of that ground zero until causes and effects become clearer. And who can blame them? In the mean time, the Thoroughbred industry pushes ahead, past a weak bloodstock market and into the new year. What will 2002 bring us? *AOB*

Kentucky's Field of Dreams

Point Given, Tiznow star in new sire crop

With Kentucky being the heart of the Thoroughbred industry, the stallions that retire to stud there every spring are considered the elite of the elite. The 2002 season will be no exception, which is why Tiznow, last year's Horse of the Year and this year's repeat winner of the Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) now calls the Bluegrass home. The brilliant Point Given also retires to Kentucky. Here are some suggestions on what bloodlines might cross with these newcomers.

A P VALENTINE (1998 by A.P. Indy – Twenty Eight Carat by Alydar) Ashford, KY. The only grade one winning two-year-old son of A.P. Indy, he also broke the track record at Hialeah (8.5f.), and finished second in the Preakness (G1) and Belmont Stakes (G1) at three. From the same family as Miswaki and Southern Halo, he is free of Mr. Prospector and has only one strain of Northern Dancer. Mr. Prospector particularly appeals here. The Mr. Prospector/Buckpasser cross (in such as Seeking the Gold, Miswaki and Woodman) should work particularly well. Other Raise a Native strains such as Raise a Cup and Marshua's Dancer should also be good.

A.P. Indy has done well over Northern Dancer, and is proven with Danzig, El Gran Senor, Night Shift, Nureyev and Storm Cat. The Northern Dancer/Bold Ruler crosses (such as Storm Cat) and Northern Dancer/Buckpasser should be particularly attractive. A.P. Indy has also worked with mares by, or descending from Clever Trick; the Turn-to line stallions Cox's Ridge, Cure the Blues and Roberto; Hoist the Flag; His Majesty; In Reality; Bold Ruler (through On to Glory and Spectacular Bid); and Private Account.

ALBERT THE GREAT (1997 by Go for Gin – Bright Feather by Fappiano) Three Chimneys, KY. One of the leaders of his generation at three and four years, he retires with earnings of over \$3,000,000 and victories in the Jockey Club Gold Cup (G1), Suburban Handicap (G2), Brooklyn Handicap (G2), Dwyer Stakes (G2) and Widener Handicap (G3). Broodmare sire Fappiano did well with In Reality, who is also the broodmare sire of Champion Saratoga Dew, a son of Albert the Great's grandsire, Cormorant.

Albert the Great is half-brother to stakes winner Sheer Bliss, by In Reality's son, Relaunch. He's also half-brother to stakes winner Watch the Bird by Rahy (by Blushing Groom). The dam is bred on a Mr. Prospector/Northern Dancer cross, so try mares which are bred on the same cross, the reverse cross, or are by sires bred on one of those two nicks. Vice Regent (sire of the second dam) will like strains of his brother, Viceregal, and his relatives The Minstrel, Far North and Fanfreluche. The granddam is a stakes winner bred on a Northern Dancer/Buckpasser cross, so bringing that pair in together again might also work well.

APTITUDE (1997 by A.P. Indy Dokki by Northern Dancer). Juddmonte, KY. Runner-up in the 2000 Kentucky Derby (G1) and Belmont Stakes (G1), he hit peak form this

summer and fall, when he took the Hollywood Gold Cup (G1), Saratoga Breeders' Cup Handicap (G1) and Jockey Club Gold Cup (G1). Aptitude is a three-parts-brother to Sleep Easy (G1, by Seattle Slew), and his dam is half-sister to Champion Slew o' Gold (by Seattle Slew) and Belmont Stakes (G1) hero Coastal. His dam is by Northern Dancer, so that invites mares by Northern Dancer line stallions, and those with Northern Dancer/Buckpasser or Northern Dancer/Secretariat crosses should be particularly good.

Aptitude is free of Mr. Prospector, a nick with A.P. Indy, so that looks an obvious one to try. Other Raise a Native strains such as Alydar and Majestic Prince (sire of Coastal) also appeal. Aptitude's close relative Slew o' Gold sired stakes winners out of mares by Key to the Mint, Stage Door Johnny and Transworld, Gallant Romeo, Knightly Manner (by Round Table) and Sharpen Up. Other strains which have worked with A.P. Indy include Clever Trick, Cox's Ridge, Cure the Blues and Roberto, Hoist the Flag, His Majesty, In Reality, On to Glory, Spectacular Bid and Private Account.

BLACK MINNALOUSHE (1998 by Storm Cat – Coral Dance by Green Dance) Ashford, KY. Winner of both of his starts at two, Black Minnaloushe trained on at three to take the Irish 2,000 Guineas (G1) and St. James's Palace Stakes (G1). By Storm Cat out of a mare by Green Dancer, he is half-brother to English 2,000 Guineas (G1) winner Pennekamp, and to U.S. grade one winner, Nasr El Arab.

Black Minnaloushe is free of Raise a Native, and Storm Cat has done well with that strain, particularly through Mr. Prospector (Mr. Prospector/Buckpasser should be particularly good), Exclusive Native and Alydar. Blushing Groom is another cross which appears promising. The Ribot line also looks good here, particularly through Tom Rolfe, His Majesty and Graustark. Storm Cat and Nijinsky II both do well with Damascus, and Private Account, ought to work especially well here. Pennekamp, is by Bering, a son of Arctic Tern; and Nasr El Arab is by Al Nasr, who is out of a mare by Caro, another strain which has worked with Storm Cat.

BRAHMS (1997 by Danzig – Queena by Mr. Prospector) Vinery, KY. Runner-up in the Dewhurst Stakes (G1) at two, Brahms was undefeated at three when he won the Seattle Slew Stakes, River City Handicap (G3) and Early Times Hollywood Derby (G1). He is by Danzig out of Champion Queena, who is in turn by Mr. Prospector out of Blushing Groom's grade one winning daughter, Too Chic. Sending Brahms mares from the Mr. Prospector line will give the oft successful pattern of inbreeding to the broodmare sire of the sire. Raise a Native's other outstanding stallion son, Alydar will also work well, as might Majestic Prince.

Danzig has a strong affinity for Turn-to and his son, Hail to Reason, and Roberto looks to have strong potential here. Danzig has worked well with Ribot, and introducing Ribot especially through Graustark, His Majesty and Tom Rolfe and his son Hoist the Flag looks worthwhile. The Danzig sire

line has enjoyed considerable success with Bold Ruler line mares and particularly Seattle Slew, who looks good here, as he also has a strong affinity with Mr. Prospector. Danzig has also worked over Buckpasser, and his strain of Tom Fool will combine well with Blushing Groom. Danzig line sires have worked with breeding back to Northern Dancer through Nijinsky II another strain which has a strong affinity for Blushing Groom.

BROKEN VOW (1997 by Unbridled – Wedding Vow by Nijinsky II) Pin Oak, KY. Successful in the Sir Barton Stakes at three, he added the Ben Ali Stakes (G3) and Philip H. Iselin Handicap (G2) at four. A half-brother to stakes winner Threshold, he is out of Wedding Vow, whose siblings include stakes winners Winged Victory, Service Stripe (a promising young sire) and Puzzled Look. Since Broken Vow is by a son of Fappiano, adding more In Reality, Dr. Fager and other Rough'n Tumble looks good, as does Dr. Fager's relative, Great Above (sire of Holy Bull and broodmare sire of Housebuster). Caro is broodmare sire of Unbridled's sons Unbridled's Song and Red Bullet, so is obvious here.

Broken Vow has Northern Dancer through Nijinsky II, and a number of Northern Dancer strains are worth reintroducing in his mares, including Storm Bird/Storm Cat, The Minstrel, Far North, Vice Regent/Deputy Minister, Nureyev, Lyphard, Northern Baby, Northern Jove and Sovereign Dancer. Mares by sons or grandsons of Nijinsky II would give the pattern of inbreeding to the broodmare sire of the sire. Any Tom Fool strains, but particularly Buckpasser, should be good, as should any reinforcements of La Troienne. Alydar would give Raise a Native inbreeding via Mr. Prospector and Alydar. Damascus looks another promising strain.

ECTON PARK (1996 by Forty Niner – Daring Danzig by Danzig). Wintergreen, KY. Millionaire Ecton Park earned grade one honors when taking the Super Derby (G1) and also captured the Jim Dandy Stakes (G2). By "sire of sires" Forty Niner, he is three-parts-brother (in fact slightly more related) to graded sprinter/miler Banker's Gold, who is by Forty Niner out of Banker's Lady, a grade one winning three-parts sister to the dam of Ecton Park. Ecton Park's dam is inbred 3x3 to Nearctic, so adding more Northern Dancer would have to be done with caution. The most likely strain would be Nijinsky II, the sire of Banker's Lady.

Alibhai would work well here, sources include Graustark and His Majesty (Pleasant Colony would be particularly good). Alydar, who has an affinity with Mr. Prospector and Danzig could be also good here. Forty Niner has often done well with more Ribot (including the previously mentioned Graustark/His Majesty, and also the related Majestic Light). He also seems to like Turn-to, sources which have worked including Hail to Reason, Sir Gaylord, Ack Ack (out of a Turn-to mare and also from the same family as Tom Rolfe) and Cox's Ridge.

EL CORREDOR (1997 by Mr. Greeley – Silvery Swan by Silver Deputy). Hill 'n' Dale, KY. A lightly raced, but extremely talented sprinter/miler, El Corredor won seven of 10 starts, including the Cigar Mile (G1), Pat O'Brien

Handicap (G2) and Del Mar Breeders' Cup Handicap (G2). From the first crop by Gone West's son, Mr. Greeley, El Corredor, is out of a Silver Deputy mare (who is also dam of this year's Maria's Mon graded stakes winner Silver Tornado), and is inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector.

Silver Deputy is a Vice Regent line horse, and this might work well with daughter strains of Vice Regent, with Vice Regent's brother Viceregal, and with strains of Vice Regent's relatives The Minstrel, Far North and Fanfreluche. Other broodmare sires which have produced stakes winners for Mr. Greeley include In Reality, Roberto, Nijinsky II, Tri Jet and Never Bend.

FIVE STAR DAY (1996 by Carson City – Reggie V by Vanlandingham). Wintergreen, KY. Very speedy Mr. Prospector grandson, he won six races, \$575,365, including the A. G. Vanderbilt Handicap (G2), Phoenix Breeders' Cup Stakes (G3) and Vernon O. Underwood Stakes (G3). He is out of a half-sister to another Mr. Prospector grandson, Marquetry, and so is bred on similar lines to that horse. Five Star Day has Northern Dancer 5x4 through Nijinsky II and Vice Regent. More Northern Dancer might be acceptable through The Minstrel, Far North Storm Bird and Fanfreluche (dam of D'Accord, L'Enjoleur and Medaille d'Or).

Note that both Storm Bird and Medaille d'Or already show up in dams of stakes winners by Five Star Day's close relative Marquetry. Marquetry has also done well with mares descending from Round Table/Nasrullah crosses, with Lost Code, Cougar II and Damascus also appearing. Alydar also looks particularly well worth trying.

JUMP START (1999 by A.P. Indy – Steady Cat by Storm Cat). Overbrook, KY. Winner of his first two starts, including the Saratoga Special Stakes (G2) and runner-up in the Champagne Stakes (G1), his career prematurely ended by an injury in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1). The dam, a graded stakes placed daughter of Storm Cat, is out of a sister to Miswaki. Jump Start is inbred 3x4 to Secretariat (with another strain Somethingroyal through Sir Gaylord) and 4x4 to Buckpasser. This might invite other Nasrullah/Princequillo and Princequillo/Nasrullah crosses, and strains of the La Troienne family.

The Storm Cat strain might combine well with Nijinsky II, The Minstrel and Far North. Ribot line mares should provide a useful outcross here, and given his pedigree and his excellent value price, Jump Start looks to have the tools to add class to tough and speedy mares with pedigrees which are an outcross to his own.

KING CUGAT (1997 Kingmambo – Tricky Game by Majestic Light) Lane's End, KY. This was one of the best miler/middle distance runners of his crop and he retired with wins in the Arlington Classic (G2), Jamaica Handicap (G2), and Bowling Green Handicap (G2) among others. He's doubled to Raise a Native sireline/dam's sireline so that's obviously one strain to be avoided. Kingmambo's best work has been with mares by Sadler's Wells, Seattle Slew, Lombard, Private Account, Kris, and His Majesty.

Seattle Slew looks hopeful, since he's also a good cross for Seeking the Gold, to which this horse is a close relative, being

by a son of Mr. Prospector out of a daughter of Con Game. His Majesty also appeals since King Cugat has crosses of both Graustark and the related Majestic Light. Doubling up on Northern Dancer looks good, especially via Nureyev's relatives Topsider, Sadler's Wells, and Fairy King. Dust Commander has crosses of both High Voltage and Challedon which also appear in Tricky Game.

MINARDI (1998 by Boundary – Yarn by Mr. Prospector). Walmac, KY. He earned honors as Europe's Champion Two-Year-Old after winning the Phoenix Stakes (G1) and Middle Park Stakes (G1). A grandson of Danzig, he is half-brother to the brilliant Tale of the Cat and to the dam of Champion Johannesburg. Minardi's dam is a sister to Preach (G1), dam of Pulpit, and the granddam, graded stakes winner Narrate, is out of a daughter of Round Table's stakes winning sister, Monarchy.

Minardi should do well with Mr. Prospector, inbreeding to the broodmare sire of the sire, and will also like Raise a Native through Mr. Prospector's close relative, Alydar. Minardi has Round Table and his sister, Monarchy, and should like further Round Table, and Princequillo/ Nasrullah or Nasrullah/Princequillo strains. Danzig/Roberto is a good cross, and this should also go with the Mr. Prospector strain. A.P. Indy (by Seattle Slew) with a sister to the dam of Minardi came up with Pulpit, which points to the Seattle Slew strain. Danzig has also done very well with Ribot, particularly via Hoist the Flag, Graustark and His Majesty.

PIKEPASS (1996 by Forty Niner – Deanna's Special by Storm Bird). Spendthrift, KY. He was a stakes winner of over \$100,000 in just five starts. He's bred on a somewhat similar cross to both Forty Niner's son, End Sweep, and also Thunder Gulch, and is from the family of Capote and Broad Brush. Storm Bird line mares will give inbreeding to the broodmare sire of the sire, and Northern Dancer should also be good through Nijinsky II, Far North and The Minstrel. Forty Niner has also worked well with Northern Dancer through Danzig.

Inbreeding to Pikepass's family through Broad Brush (or introducing his sire Ack Ack), Capote (or introducing his sire, Seattle Slew), Exceller, Baldski or American Standard is to be encouraged. Forty Niner has done well with Ribot inbreeding. He also seems to like Turn-to, and strains which have worked include Hail to Reason (through daughters and also through Stop the Music and Roberto), Sir Gaylord, and Cox's Ridge.

POINT GIVEN (Thunder Gulch – Turko's Turn by Turkoman). Three Chimneys, KY. Strong contender for Horse of the Year, he may have been on his way to becoming a great one. He won the Travers (G1), Belmont Stakes (G1), Preakness Stakes (G1), Santa Anita Derby (G1) and San Felipe Stakes (G2) at three, and the Hollywood Futurity (G1) and Kentucky Cup Juvenile Stakes (G3) at two, when he was also a fast closing second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1). Point Given is bred on a cross of two lines of Raise a Native, Mr. Prospector and Alydar.

He has only a distant Northern Dancer strain, through Thunder Gulch's maternal grandsire, Storm Bird, and

should benefit from more Northern Dancer (other Northern Dancer strains which have worked with Gulch include Danzig, Lyphard, Topsider, Nureyev and Nijinsky II). Seattle Slew is good with Mr. Prospector, Alydar and Relaunch (sire of Point Given's granddam), so might do well here. Turkoman's dam is by Table Play, a horse bred on a Round Table/Nasrullah cross, which indicates Princequillo/ Nasrullah or Nasrullah/Princequillo will do well here. Gulch has done well with His Majesty, which suggests that his brother, Graustark is also workable here, and both Gulch and Thunder Gulch have worked with Blushing Groom.

STRATEGIC MISSION (1995 by Mr. Prospector – Sultry Sun by Buckfinder). Gainesway, KY. A Mr. Prospector half-brother to grade one winners Sultry Song and Solar Splendor, he earned his own graded triumph in the Fort Marcy Handicap (G3). Sultry Song is by Cox's Ridge and Solar Splendor by Majestic Light, and since both these strains are good with Mr. Prospector, they have to be high on the list here. Strategic Mission has no Northern Dancer, so again that has to be an obvious target.

Sultry Sun, the dam of Strategic Mission, is by a son of Buckpasser out of a mare by Damascus, and Private Account would reverse that cross. Private Terms is a Private Account son out of a half-sister to Buckfinder, and Icecapade (sire of Clever Trick and Wild Again) is half-brother to Buckfinder. Note that Sultry Song already has a stakes winner with Damascus inbreeding. Sultry Song also has two stakes winners out of Noholme II line mares.

TIZNOW (by Cee's Tizzy – Cee's Song by Seattle Song). WinStar, KY. For a symbol of American courage in troubled times, look no further than Tiznow, who has shown the utmost bravery to repel invaders in two consecutive Breeders' Cup Classics (G1). He is a product of the promising Relaunch/Seattle Slew cross and traces to a three-partsister to the influential Crimson Satan. This is also the family of Lively One, Swing Till Dawn and Champion English Two-Year-Old Digression. His pedigree also has the relatives The Axe II and Inquisitive (dam of Pia Star, sire of Tiznow's third dam).

The Crimson Satan strain is most commonly found in Storm Cat and Mt. Livermore. Horses containing relatives to The Axe II and Inquisitive include Our Native, Silver Buck and Hennessy (who also has Crimson Satan through Storm Cat). Halo and Grey Dawn II should also be good with this background. Tiznow is an In Reality line horse, so Dr. Fager (in Fappiano and Cure the Blues) is worth introducing. Fappiano's sons with further In Reality (Unbridled, Rubiano) should go well, and other daughter strains of In Reality could work, as in Crafty Prospector. Relaunch is good with Hail to Reason and Bold Ruler (in the broodmare sire line here through Seattle Slew, who himself likes more Bold Ruler). Any Nasrullah/Princequillo or reverse, and any La Troienne, particularly Buckpasser, might be good. **JOB**

Regional Sires Roundup

Trippi to Florida, City Zip to New York

While California lost its favorite son, Tiznow, to Kentucky connections, the new West Coast contingent of sires is an interesting one. Florida also gains quite a few talented new faces, as does New York. Read on for some suggestions as to what bloodlines seem most appealing for these first season sires.

ARKANSAS

CORNISH SNOW (1993 Storm Cat – Pleasantly Free by Pleasant Colony) Tooth-Acres, AR. This was a stakes winner with some durability, remarkable for a Storm Cat, making 46 starts with 12 wins and earnings of \$351,149. He's bred on the Storm Cat/Ribot nick, and his dam is inbred to Ribot, so introducing a strain of Ribot's son, Graustark, would be interesting, to cross on his full brother, His Majesty. Look for Nijinsky II or The Minstrel, which has crossed well with both Storm Bird and Pleasant Colony. Cornish Snow's second dam is by Thatch, so look for Nureyev, Geiger Counter, or others carrying Thatch's sister Thong.

CALIFORNIA

DIXIE DOT COM (1995 Dixie Brass – Sky Meadows by Conquistador Cielo) Cardiff Stud, CA. A top class handicapper who outran his pedigree, Dixie Dot Com has hooks into a lot of pedigrees. He's bred on the Dixieland Band/Mr. Prospector nick, a next generation cross of Northern Dancer on Mr. Prospector, so look for the same in reverse. Dixie Brass' dam was by Sham, from the same family as Tom Rolfe, Chieftain, and Ack Ack, all of which would be good here. This mare also has Princequillo on Bold Ruler, so look for the reverse in the likes of Secretariat, Envoy, Blade, Bold Lad or even Bold Bidder. His dam is inbred to Turn-to via Tammy's Turn and First Landing.

Try the more potent strains of Hail to Reason or Sir Gaylord to reintroduce that pattern. Dixie Dot Com's second dam is a half-sister to the second dam of Carson City, who would be very interesting here, since he's also from the Mr. Prospector line, like Conquistador Cielo.

GLOBALIZE (1997 Summer Squall – Sugar Hill Chick by Fit To Fight) Creston, CA. He won the California Juvenile (G3) at two and the Spiral Stakes (G2) at three. His pedigree features 4x4x5 crosses of Bold Ruler, twice through the dam. It might be interesting to double Bold Ruler's son Secretariat this time, or try a cross of King Emperor, whose sister, Queen Empress is the fourth dam here.

This is a son of Summer Squall, who loves Mr. Prospector line mares, as well as Blushing Groom and Nijinsky II/The Minstrel. Look for any of these good nicks, or try those working with his three-quarter relative Storm Cat, which include those as well as Ribot and Affirmed. Look for Tom Rolfe to cross on his half-brother Chieftain, or Ack Ack and Sham from the same female line. Try daughters of Damascus and sons of Hail to Reason. Riverman could work here, too.

MADRAAR (1994 Mr. Prospector – Jood by Nijinsky II) Hideaway, CA. What a coup! This was a seven time winner in Dubai, but he's also a half-brother to European Horse of the Year Fantastic Light. The latter's sire, Rahy is an obvious choice here, or any cross of Blushing Groom to take advantage of that Nijinsky II cross. Other Northern Dancer strains to try here include Storm Bird, Storm Cat, Summer Squall, The Minstrel and Far North. His dam, Jood, is from a family that has worked very well with Seattle Slew and Buckpasser bloodlines. Look for His Majesty or Alleged to cross on Key to the Mint in the second dam. Key to the Kingdom would be interesting, a half-brother to Key to the Mint. This is the Sybil's Sister family so look for more crosses of Nearctic here, which besides Northern Dancer would include Explodent, Briartic, or Icecapade.

MENHAL (1997 Danzig – Coxwold by Cox's Ridge) Black Oak, CA. This horse was a winner on the track and a son of the good racemare Coxwold, placed in the Beldame Stakes (G1). He is also a three-quarter relative to the stakes winner Magical Strike, by Danzig and out of Coxwold's dam, Egyptian Rose by Sir Ivor. Egyptian Rose was herself a half-sister to the top runners De La Rose and Upper Nile, so their sire Nijinsky should be a target strain here. Danzig's good nicks include Sir Ivor (already here), Buckpasser, and Ribot. His dam is doubled to Turn-to, but he's himself an outcross, so introduce another cross of Turn-to, perhaps even doubling up on Sir Ivor himself. If not that, try Sir Ivor's sire Sir Gaylord, whose half-brother Secretariat works well with Sir Ivor. There are also two crosses of Fair Trial here, so look for Lyphard, Nureyev or Theatrical to build on that by doubling Northern Dancer at the same time.

FLORIDA

CLOUD HOPPING (1997 Mr. Prospector – Skimble by Lyphard) Wycombe House, FL. This is a winning half-brother to the outstanding grade one winner Skimming (by Nureyev). Mares by Nureyev or his sons are the obvious choice here, or try those by the closely-related Sadler's Wells, Fairy King, or Topsider. This is a son of Mr. Prospector, whose other good nicks include In Reality, which shouldn't be too hard to find in Florida, as in Valid Appeal. Also look for Seattle Slew and Buckpasser. Bucksplasher is out of a Northern Dancer mare, and this cross would repeat the Northern Dancer duplication found in Skimming's pedigree. His second dam is by Cyane, a son of Turn-to, which begs for more Turn-to, so look for Hail to Reason, Sir Gaylord, or other sources.

DELAWARE TOWNSHIP (1996 Notebook – Sunny Mimosa by Sunny North) Padua, FL. Top class sprinter earned nearly a million dollars and closed out his career with his second grade one win, in the Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash. He is the best son of Notebook, who has had

success with Cutlass (inbreeding to Ghazni), Nodouble, Bold Ruler and In Reality line mares. At outcross at four generations, every quadrant has a hook into popular strains that gives him a lot of potential. Look for Majestic Light, sons of Tom Rolfe or In Reality. Victorious was a half-brother to Notebook's sire Well Decorated; El Prado is a Northern Dancer line horse from the same family of Notebook. Night Invader is from the family of Sunny North. Also try Damascus, Skip Trial, Afleet and his son Rizzi.

EXCHANGE RATE (1997 Danzig – Sterling Pound by Seeking the Gold) Padua Stables, FL. This son of Danzig should like his sire's best nicks, to Sir Ivor, Buckpasser, and Ribot. He's 2x5 to Northern Dancer, so a third strain wouldn't be too risky especially through Lyphard or Nureyev. His dam is inbred to Raise a Native while he's an outcross to that pattern, which indicates that a return to Raise a Native should be beneficial. Avoid more Mr. Prospector, but look for other strains such as Alydar or Raise a Cup. Look for opportunities to double up on the top matrons Broadway and Native Partner, both found in his dam. Look for Reviewer, Northern Flagship, Formidable, and Arazi.

FLAME THROWER (1998 Saint Ballado – Metromane by Metrogrand) Stoneriggs, FL. One of the best juveniles of his crop and one of the best sons of his sire, Flame Thrower has real prospects. He's an outcross through five generations, so closer inbreeding is a must for him.

Look for Rahy, out of a sister to Saint Ballado for the most dramatic version. Grey Dawn II was bred similarly to Saint Ballado's dam, Ballade, with the Herbager/Mahmoud cross. Saint Ballado also does well with duplicating his male line cross of Hail to Reason. Flame Thrower's dam was a good regional filly from a quirky pedigree so look there for clues. She's linebred to War Relic, which demands the input of In Reality, who was also inbred to War Relic 3x3. Also look for Caro, the dam's sire of the similarly-bred Yankee Victor, whose second dam is by Wajima, a half-brother to Flame Thrower's second damsire Naskra.

LEXICON (1995 Conquistador Cielo – Felidia by Golden Fleece) Meadowbrook, FL. A useful son of Conquistador Cielo who is no slouch as a sire of sires (if you like Marquetry and Norquestor). Conquistador Cielo has done very well with doubling up on his cross of Turn-to so try that here, as well. This one is 3x4 to Raise a Native, which is the bloodline to be avoided. Look instead to double his dam's line of Northern Dancer and Nijinsky II. Be My Guest would be interesting, bred similarly to Golden Fleece, so look for mares by his sons Assert or Go and Go.

MIDDLESEX DRIVE (1995 Pine Bluff – York Woods by Mining) Dunhill, FL. A top grass runner, this one has plays to any of the major bloodlines. He's from the Northern Dancer male line, and his sire also has a cross of Hail to Reason. His dam is from the Mr. Prospector line. The only thing that seems to be missing is Bold Ruler or Seattle Slew. Mining was inbred to Raise a Native, but that pattern has been intelligently ignored in the mating of his dam and himself.

Now it might be time to bring back a third cross of Raise a Native, perhaps via Seeking the Gold, Woodman or Miswaki, all bred on the same Mr. Prospector/Buckpasser cross as Mining. This horse has a unique 5x4 double to Crafty Admiral, which hints that he might do well with Affirmed, from the Raise a Native line and out of a mare by Crafty Admiral.

PRIME TIMBER (1996 Sultry Song – Wine Taster by Nodouble) Sez Who, FL. Placed in the Hollywood Futurity (G1) at two, he won the San Felipe Handicap (G2) at three. He represents a good nick for his sire, who has also done well with Strike the Anvil (by Bolinas Boy), Theatrical and Damascus. He's from the Turn-to male line, so add more of the same. His sire is a half-brother to Solar Splendor, a grade one winner by Majestic Light, who should also cross well here.

Anything with a daughter of Buckpasser would sex balance Buckfinder, dam's sire of Sultry Song. Try doubling up on Damascus, sire of the second dam of Sultry Song. His dam's sire was Nodouble, who nicked well with Prince John. The second dam is by Finnegan, who also appears as the dam's sire of Phone Trick, so look for Clever Trick or Icecapade.

PUT IT BACK (1998 Honour and Glory – Miss Shoplifter by Exuberant) Bridlewood, FL. One of his first stakes winners, and the first son of Honour and Glory at stud, he brings the Relaunch branch of the In Reality line to Florida. This is far enough back to take advantage of some of the successful doubling to In Reality we've been seeing lately. Honour and Glory is from the same Cequillo family as Ogygian and Fappiano, who might work here.

Also look for a male strain of Caro to cross on Al Nasr's dam. Exuberant was a son of What a Pleasure, so look for Sovereign Dancer or Gate Dancer to double up on Grey Flight. Exuberant was from the same female line as It's Freezing, which would be interesting. The third dam is a daughter of Speak John, who might appreciate a cross of Speak John's son, Hold Your Peace.

SONG AND A PRAYER (1998 Unbridled's Song – Alizea by Premiership) Marablu, FL. The first son of Unbridled's Song at stud, this one was also one of his first stakes winners. He's male line/male line 5x4 Raise a Native, with a third cross tucked away in his second dam, so we have to recommend staying away from that one. But look for daughter strains of Native Dancer via Northern Dancer, who doesn't appear here at all. The Fappiano line loves Florida's In Reality line, so definitely try that.

Unbridled's Song is from the same family as Seattle Song, who could be useful here, as might any other son of Seattle Slew. One might even try a son strain of Caro to balance Unbridled's Song's mother. Premiership is out of a daughter of Never Bend, so look for sons such as Iron Ruler, Distinctive, and Riverman.

The next dam is by Well Decorated, by Raja Baba, so things from the Missy Baba family would be interesting such as Plugged Nickle, Sauce Boat, Honor Grades, Summer Squall, and A.P. Indy.

TRIPPI (1997 End Sweep – Jealous Appeal by Valid Appeal) Ocala Stud, FL. One of the best sons of End Sweep comes back to Florida. This one was a grade one winning sprinter. He's a half-brother to two stakes winners by Baldski, so there's the most obvious nick.

One might also try other Nijinsky II sources, or Too Bald sources such as American Standard, Exceller, or Capote. His sire is bred on the Mr. Prospector/Northern Dancer nick, so adding more Northern Dancers should give a boost. Another shot of Raise a Native shouldn't hurt, either. His dam is by Valid Appeal, which invites more of his sire In Reality. Also try Roberto, a nick with In Reality, which introduces the Turn-to line here, which should blend well with the second dam, carrying crosses of Madara and Nasrullah. A son of Never Bend balances the daughter, his third dam, so look for Iron Ruler, Distinctive, and Riverman.

MARYLAND

DISCO RICO (1997 Citidancer – Round It Off by Apalachee) tba, MD. This was an extremely fast sprinter with a very interesting pedigree. His sire is inbred to Northern Dancer and his dam is inbred to the siblings Moccasin and Ridan (both by Nantallah – Rough Shod II). This combination screams for Nureyev, Topsider, Sadler's Wells or Fairy King, sons of Northern Dancer from Rough Shod II family. Sire Citidancer crosses with a lot of different strains, but has done well with Mr. Prospector, and Maryland has two top strains in Allen's Prospect and Two Punch. Other good Citidancer nicks include Pleasant Colony, Shelter Half, Bold Forbes and Robellino. Bold Ruler would be especially good to cross on Round Table. Add more Turn-to via Sir Gaylord and First Landing. Noble Jay would be interesting crossed on the second dam.

MOJAVE MOON (1996 Mr. Prospector – East of the Moon by Private Account) Bonita, MD. This horse was twice graded stakes placed and is a three-quarter relative to Kingmambo. Kingmambo has done well with Seattle Slew, Sadler's Wells, His Majesty and the related Majestic Light among his best runners. Dam's sire Private Account is from the same family as Maryland sires Polish Numbers and Not For Love, so their daughters should work well here. Look for daughter strains of Damascus, or additional Buckpasser as well. The second dam is the great mare Miesque, by Nureyev, so try doubling that sire or his sire, Northern Dancer, especially via close relatives Sadler's Wells, Fairy King, and Topsider. Wayne County daughters would be good.

MICHIGAN

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS (1994 Sky Classic – Wortheroat-singold by Naskra) Stonewood, MI. Here's a durable warrior who made 34 starts, winning eight including \$461,285 and the Oceanport H. (G3). He's by the top Nijinsky II son Sky Classic, who has done well with Raise a Native, Bold Ruler and Northern Dancer line mares as well as the Naskra nick here. Sky Classic was a half-brother to top runners by Vice Regent, Grey Dawn II, Smarten, and Deputy Minister, all top potential nicks here.

Naskra was a half-brother to champion Wajima, and crossing the two might make some good by doubling up their good dam, Iskra. The second dam was a sister to Sauce Boat and close relative to Plugged Nickle. Look for Raja Baba or other members of the Missy Baba family including Summer Squall, A.P. Indy, and Honor Grades. Look for mares with Nasrullah/Princequillo crosses.

NEW JERSEY

DEPUTY WARLOCK (1997 Silver Deputy – Date Stone by Forty Niner) Tee-N-Jay, NJ. This was a very good two-year-old, winner of the Cradle Stakes and Hawthorne Juvenile. He's 3x3 to Mr. Prospector which tells you what bloodline NOT to add here. It would probably also be a good idea to avoid any more Raise a Native as well.

Instead, concentrate on his male line back to Northern Dancer. Silver Deputy nicked very well with Bold Ruckus and might like other Boldnesian or Bold Ruler lines, including Seattle Slew. There are already three lines of Turn-to here, but two are in the second dam, so a return to that linebreeding might work. Concern looks favorable, and would double up on Ack Ack. Try doubling up on Ribot, in Forty Niner's dam, since he did well with that scheme himself.

IRON PUNCH (1994 Iron – Fast Breakfast by Medieval Man) Casino Royale, NJ. A good local handicapper, winner of the Philadelphia Park Breeders' Cup Handicap (G3, ntr). He's by Iron, a Mr. Prospector half brother to Coastal and Slew o' Gold, so look for their sires, Majestic Prince (via Majestic Light) and Seattle Slew. Also look to double up on Buckpasser, found in their dam, Alluvial. Medieval Man is also the dam's sire of Horse of the Year Favorite Trick, which makes crosses of his sire, Phone Trick or other Clever Trick crosses hopeful. The second dam was by Fleet Host, whose sire My Host was a close relative to the dams of His Majesty, Graustark, and Majestic Prince. Majestic Light really looks like a golden cross here.

NEW MEXICO

NORWAY (1998 Storm Cat – Weekend Surprise by Secretariat) Double L, NM. Wow. This one was only placed, but topped the Keeneland July sale three years ago. He's 3x2 to Secretariat. Obviously that's a line to avoid, but look for more Bold Ruler/Princequillo crosses or Nasrullah/Princequillo crosses. Seattle Slew looks great, especially since he sired Norway's half-brother A.P. Indy. Riverman also looks good. Storm Cat's nicks are with Affirmed, Alydar, Mr. Prospector, and Ribot line mares, especially Graustark and His Majesty. This is the same female line as Raja Baba, Plugged Nickle, and Sauce Boat.

NEW YORK

CITY ZIP (1998 by Carson City – Baby Zip by Relaunch) Contemporary Stallions, NY. City Zip has strong claims as the best two-year-old ever to enter stud in New York. He won the Hopeful Stakes (G1), Saratoga Special (G2), Sanford Stakes (G2), and Tremont Stakes (G3) and was first past the

post in the Futurity Stakes (G1). At three, he captured another four stakes, including the Amsterdam Stakes (G2) and Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup Stakes (G3). The son of Carson City is out of the stakes winning Relaunch mare, Baby Zip. His second dam is the prolific stakes winning Tri Jet mare, Thirty Zip. He has only one strain of Northern Dancer, and so should be well suited by most Northern Dancer line mares, as is his sire. Relaunch, is a son of In Reality, and this strain has worked well with horses carrying Rough 'n Tumble through sons like Dr. Fager (in New York via Dr. Blum and Cure the Blues). Relaunch will also like the strains of Halo and Grey Dawn II. Carson City has also worked well with Bold Ruler, and Turn-to, particularly through the half-brothers Secretariat and Sir Gaylord.

DEPUTY CAT (1998 by Deputy Minister – Cat Attack by Storm Cat) Pegasus, NY. Although unraced, he has pedigree aplenty as he is by Deputy Minister out of a graded stakes winning daughter of Storm Cat. The most promising cross here should be the Raise a Native strain, particularly through Exclusive Native, Mr. Prospector and Alydar. Both Deputy Minister and Storm Cat have affinities for Seattle Slew, Blushing Groom and Damascus. Both have also done well with Ribot through Hoist the Flag.

Deputy Minister loves the strain of Bold Ruckus. Deputy Minister and Storm Cat have also both succeeded with Sharpen Up and there is a very good Sharpen Up line runner under the second dam of the mare.

FREUD (1998 by Storm Cat – Mariah's Storm by Rahy) Lakland North, NY. A brother to Giant's Causeway, he captured his maiden and also finished third in the Cork and Orrery Stakes (G3). He is out of Mariah's Storm, a multiple graded stakes winner of nearly \$725,000, and his second dam, Immense, a graded stakes winning daughter of Rooberto, is half-sister to Champion Two-Year-Old Filly Dearly Precious.

Freud will be suited by returns of Northern Dancer through Nijinsky II, The Minstrel and Far North, all relatives to Storm Bird, the sire of Storm Cat. He is free of Raise a Native, and will do well with that strain via Mr. Prospector, Alydar and Exclusive Native. Other strains which have done well with Storm Cat and which could work here include Ribot (particularly through Hoist the Flag, Graustark and His Majesty), Damascus and Seattle Slew.

MANCINI (1998 by Mr. Prospector – Trolley Song by Caro) Liberty Stud, NY. He is three-parts brother to Unbridled's Song, sire of the Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1), winner Unbridled Elaine, and Fountain of Youth Stakes (G1) victor, Song and a prayer. Mancini doesn't have the In Reality and Dr. Fager strains which are in Unbridled, the sire of Unbridled's Song, so those could be well worth adding (sources easily found in New York include Dr. Blum, Cure the Blues and Obligato).

The pedigree is free of Northern Dancer, which has been a great cross for Mr. Prospector. There is also no Bold Ruler, and the female line has produced the good Bold Ruler line horses Merlin's Charm (by Bold Bidder), Bashful Charm (by Capote) and Seattle Song (by Capote's sire, Seattle Slew), so

that line might be worth trying. One New York source would be Spectacular Bid, a son of Bold Bidder.

RADIO STAR (1997 by Storm Cat – Andover Way by His Majesty) McMahon, NY. A maiden winner in England, and an allowance winner sprinting at Aqueduct, this is a horse with a real stallion pedigree. He is by significant sire of sires Storm Cat, and also half-brother to Dynaformer.

Radio Star is free of Raise a Native, and Storm Cat has done well with that strain, particularly through Mr. Prospector, Alydar and Exclusive Native. Majestic Light, a relative to His Majesty would also go well, as would His Majesty's brother, Graustark. Storm Cat hasn't generally been a great success with Roberto, but since Dynaformer is a son of Roberto, it might be worth taking the chance here. Radio Star is also half-brother to a stakes winner by Seattle Slew, another strain with an affinity for Storm Cat. Dynaformer has worked well with Dr. Fager, including Dr. Blum, and also look out for In Reality and Damascus.

RAWAFED (1996 by Kingmambo – Halholah by Secretariat) to be announced, NY. This lightly-raced son of superstar sire, Kingmambo, is out of a daughter of the Mother Goose Stakes (G1) winner Sugar and Spice, and is from the same family as Alydar and Grand Slam. He is from the Mr. Prospector male line and inbred to Northern Dancer, so one might need to stay away from those strains. Raise a Native through Alydar or his relative Raise A Cup might be interesting, however.

There are two son strains of Graustark here, so a daughter of His Majesty, or a strain of Majestic Light (broodmare sire of Kingmambo's good winner, King Cugat) could work. Wild Again has worked well with this family. Other strains which have worked with Kingmambo include Seattle Slew, Damascus, Caro, Hoist the Flag and Prince John.

SANDPILE (1995 by Cure the Blues – Geraldine by Deputy Minister) The Stallion Park, NY. This son of the late New York stallion king, Cure the Blues, raced only at two, when he won three of four starts, including the New York Stallion Times Square Stakes.

His dam is half-sister to stakes winner and producer She's A Shaker, out of Talc Shaker, a stakes winner of over \$230,000. In female line, he goes back to a close relative to the great mare Fanfreluche, so look for her sons, D'Accord, Medaille d'Or, and L'Enjoleur. Cure the Blues worked with a wide range of broodmare sires, but successful strains include Seattle Slew, In Reality, Tom Fool, Secretariat (three-parts-brother to the granddam of Cure the Blues), Tom Rolfe, Le Fabuleux and Hoist the Flag. Cure the Blues sired a graded stakes winner out of a mare by Gulch, whose brother Big Mukora is sire of a stakes winner from this family. Exclusive Native would go well here.

SATELLITE SUN (1996 by Seattle Slew – Sultry Sun by Buckfinder) Four Green Fields, NY. Although unraced, he certainly has plenty of pedigree, as he is a Seattle Slew half-brother to Sultry Song (G1) and Solar Splendor (G1) and 2001 graded stakes winner Strategic Mission, and out of a graded stakes winning mare.

He is free of Mr. Prospector and Northern Dancer, both of which combine well with Seattle Slew. Buckfinder, is half-brother to Icecapade and On to Glory, and to the dam of Private Terms, and mares carrying those horses could all do well here. Satellite Sun's grade one winning half-brothers are by Cox's Ridge and Majestic Light, suggesting they could be good here too.

WATCH THE BIRD (1995 Rahy – Bright Feather by Fappiano) Centerbrook, NY. Winner of the Whirlaway Stakes, his pedigree is the height of fashion. Rahy has had a tremendous last two seasons, capped by Fantastic Light's Breeders' Cup Turf (G1) victory.

Watch The Bird is half-brother to Albert the Great, one of the top colts of the last two seasons, by former New York leading sire Cormorant, from the His Majesty (Ribot) line. He is also a half-brother to stakes winner Sheer Bliss is by Relaunch (by In Reality). There is a distant strain of Northern Dancer in this pedigree (through Vice Regent), but Rahy has been so good with Northern Dancer, it is well worth bringing in more (Nijinsky II and Northern Dancer/Buckpasser crosses being particularly good). Rahy has done well with Seattle Slew's son, Slew o' Gold, too.

ONTARIO, CANADA

PERIGEE MOON (1998 Hennessy – Lovlier Linda by Vigors) Park Stud, ONT. The first stakes winner by Hennessy and his first son to go to stud, Perigee Moon has a lot to offer. He's a half-brother to Old Trieste, so try his sire, A.P. Indy or another Seattle Slew line horse. Their dam, Lovlier Linda was a top racemare and half-sister to stakes winners by Bicker and Gummo, so look for their sires Round Table or Fleet Nasrullah as potential nicks. This horse is one of the very few Hennessys that doesn't have Mr. Prospector in it's dam, so that's a prime nick. He's very outcrossed, so look for additional crosses of Northern Dancer, Secretariat, Grey Dawn II, Herbager, and My Babu.

OREGON

KLINSMAN (IRE) (1995 Danehill – Faakirah by Dragomara Palace) Oakhurst, OR. This was a good runner, winner of four races and placed third in the San Bernardino Handicap (G2). He's also a rarity in America, being a son of Danehill. Danehill has done well with a variety of mares including those from the lines of Nijinsky II, Northern Dancer, Mr. Prospector, Sharpen Up, Star Kingdom, Sir Tristram. He's especially done well with background strains of Fair Trial and Hyperion, Vaguely Noble, for instance. Klinzman's dam is by a horse from the Grey Sovereign line, next dam by Sing Sing (by Tudor Minstrel), third dam by Vilmorin (by Gold Bridge). Double up especially on Tudor Minstrel and Gold Bridge.

PENNSYLVANIA

COASTAL STORM (1999 Storm Cat – Pearl City by Carson City) Pin Oak Lane, PA. This colt was unraced but what a pedigree! His dam is the very accomplished race mare

Pearl City, one of the best by Carson City. He's bred on the Northern Dancer/Mr. Prospector cross. Try doubling either Northern Dancer (especially via Nijinsky II already in Carson City's dam; or The Minstrel) or Raise a Native, but NOT Mr. Prospector.

Ribot is one of the top nicks for Storm Cat, so look for His Majesty and Graustark. Affirmed is another good nick, doubling Raise a Native in this case but through a relatively sound strain. Try more Secretariat, and note that daughters of the West Virginia sire My Boy Adam (by Encino) would also double up on Nijinsky II and the blue hen mare Crimson Saint. Look for more Bold Ruler, which nicks with Hawaii, in the second dam.


TEXAS

REPORT ON RAIN (1994 Corporate Report – My Rainbow by Lyphard). Guerra, TX. A tough, consistent winner of 14 races in 46 starts, earning \$236,320, he's by a proven son of Private Account from the Damascus line, so look for good crosses to Bold Ruler, Never Bend, and other Nasrullah line sires. The sire is also linebred to War Admiral, so look for more of that, especially via Buckpasser or other La Troienne strains.

Also try Key to the Mint's close relative Alleged, or Graustark's brother His Majesty. The dam is a half-sister to two stakes horses by Storm Cat, so that's an obvious choice. The third dam is a half-sister to Halo, another possibility. Doubling up to Northern Dancer would continue the pattern of linebreeding to Almahmoud already in the dam. There's also a distant pattern of linebreeding to Cosmic Bomb, so introduce Prince John, whose dam was his half-sister.

WEST VIRGINIA

CATASTROPHE (1997 Storm Cat – Real Jenny by Valid Appeal) Beau Ridge, WV. This is a winner by sire of sires Storm Cat. Look for his sire's best nicks to Affirmed, Alydar, Mr. Prospector, Ribot, Graustark, and Damascus. The Storm Cat invites some daring inbreeding using daughters of local sire My Boy Adam (by Encino). Try daughter strains of In Reality. He's linebred to the close relatives Bolero Rose and Rare Perfume, so look for more of this family 8, as in Be My Guest (sire of Assert and Go and Go). He should also do well with Bold Ruler and Dixieland Band.

MEDFORD (1995 Meadowlake – Really Quick by In Reality) Fleetwood, WV. A juvenile stakes winner from a precocious male line, he's bred the part, being 3x4 to Raise a Native. That's obviously a line to avoid in his matings. Instead, concentrate on finding Stage Door Johnny, which blends well with Meadowlake's grandsire Speak John, or double up on In Reality via a son. Tentam, by In Reality's sire, Intentionally, could also be useful. Look for Hail to Reason via his good son Roberto.

A Turn of the Wheel

The silver lining behind every cloud

Sometimes the sequence of events in horse racing is remarkable. As we've noted before, the "exported sire syndrome" is all but scientific fact in the minds of stallion managers and breeders. Take any stallion and sell him to a foreign land, and nothing is surer to precipitate that sire's biggest winner in his former homeland.

Recent memory alone accounts for End Sweep (currently eleventh on the General Sires List), Twining (fifteenth), and Dehere (twentieth). The English learned their lesson with Generous, who has been returned to stud there after several seasons in Japan.

Likewise, a death may be made bittersweet, or show us another turn of the great wheel of life. We are particularly fortunate in our industry to raise a product that has been recycling itself for generations. Every year we watch them scramble to their feet as foals. Every year we see some claimed by disease or age. Or, as we've all come to recognize dealing with horses, and with Thoroughbreds in particular, they are bent on self-destruction, and can succumb to unfortunate accidents.

Just before this year's Breeders' Cup Day, we got word that Unbridled had died, the result of a chronic battle with colic. So it was with extra sadness that we watched Exogenous' tragic struggle as she went to the post for the Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1). Exogenous was a grey daughter of Unbridled and much of the crowd hoped that this extremely talented daughter would send her sire's memory off with one last hurrah. It was not to be.

The winner, instead, was another grey filly, ironically named Unbridled Elaine. She is a daughter of Unbridled's first outstanding runner, Unbridled's Song, currently the leading second crop sire in North America. And so the wheel turns.

Second crop status

According to *The Blood-Horse's* latest numbers (from the November 24 issue), other leaders among second crop sires include Maria's Mon, Hennessy, Honour and Glory and Forest Wildcat. Here are a couple other interesting statistics from that "top 70" list. The leader by percent of winners to foals is Bartok, who had only five foals in his first crop, and all five have run, for 100 percent results.

Foxtrail, with 48 foals, had 38 runners, or 79 percent of his foals. Judge T C and Bright Launch had 77 percent runners to winners. Storm Creek, Valid Wager, Petionville, Golden Gear, Demaloot Demashoot, Hunting Hard, Muhtafal, and Level Sands all had at least 70 percent runners to foals.

Percent of runners to winners is another interesting category. The leader here again is Bartok, with 60 percent winners to runners, since three of his five foals have won. The runner-up is Bright Launch, with 55 percent winners, followed by Valid Wager and Muhtafal (54 percent), and Mutakddim, Petionville, Demaloot Demashoot, Patton,

Sea Salute, Foxtrail, Level Sands, and Dixie Power all with a winners to foals ration of over 43 percent.

By Average Earnings Index (AEI), they rank this way: Bartok (5.39), Service Stripe (3.22), Unbridled's Song (2.32), Maria's Mon (2.08), Mutakddim (2.06), Muhtafal (2.05), Forest Wildcat (1.98), Hennessy (1.88), Tethra (1.85), and Northern Spur (1.83).

One horse who keeps showing up on this list is Muhtafal, who stood briefly at Shadwell Stud in Kentucky before he was sold to stand at Summerhill Stud in South Africa. This brother to Canadian Champion Afleet seems like he would have been a useful sire here. One real surprise is Northern Spur, who has already sired two stakes winners in North America, an early showing that we admittedly wouldn't have expected from a winner of the Breeders' Cup Turf (G1). Add him to the list of proven Sadler's Wells sires.


Third crop sires

The leader far and away over all third crop sires is Thunder Gulch. Honestly, did any of us ever imagine this sort of stud performance when the feisty little guy won the Kentucky Derby and Belmont Stakes back in 1995? He was a son of Gulch, who wasn't knocking anyone's socks off as a sire, not like his other Mr. Prospector line contemporaries Seeking the Gold or Forty Niner. Thunder Gulch's dam was also a daughter of the relatively cold Storm Bird. (Oh wait, wasn't he the sire of Storm Cat?) And the second dam was Shoot A Line, a champion staying filly in England from English bloodlines most of us didn't recognize.

This guy won twice at 10 furlongs (Kentucky Derby and Travers) and once at 12 furlongs (Belmont Stakes), so it looked like he was taking after his dam's side of the family as a middle distance runner. And while he was handsome, he was very small. Oh my. Not the kind of horse the market usually falls in love with.

In fact, it looked to be an uphill battle, which is probably why the good people at Coolmore/Ashford hedged their bets and sent the little fellow to Japan for his fourth season in 1999 to keep him out of sight, fingers crossed, while his first two-year-olds proved him or humiliated him. They showed enough to be encouraging, especially for a stallion who had himself improved dramatically from two to three. Lucky for us that was only a one-year lease, eh?

Thunder Gulch is currently the Leading Sire for 2001. He's represented by seven stakes winners of 18 stakes, topped by leading earner, the three-year-old division leader Point Given, winner of the Preakness and Belmont Stakes. Thunder Gulch's other top winners this year include Tweed-side (G1), Tempest Morn (G1 Aus), Spain (G2), Balbina (G3 Aus), and Vita (G3 Aus). Like Unbridled and Cryptoclearance, he represents another strip of the Mr. Prospector line that is taking a more classic approach than expected.

Speed rules, but a little bit of stamina seems to go a very long way.

Werk Thoroughbred Consultants, Inc. compiles data relating to North American unrestricted stakes races with a purse of \$25,000 or more and black-type qualifying races in Europe. WTC recorded the individual stakes winners (SWs) from January 1 through November 14, 2001,

Another Valid Performance

Two ex-Mockingbird stallions lead the juvenile sires

With six weeks to go in the racing season of 2001, it looks like Valid Expectations (24 winners) will take home the prize as leading freshman sire by both winners and earnings. His closest pursuer remains, as it has for several weeks, Open Forum, his stablemate both initially at Mockingbird Farm in Florida and now at Huisache Farm in Texas. Open Forum (18) has a shot to catch him in the money title but to pick up six new winners by year's end looks like a tall task. Smoke Glacken remains in the show spot with 15 winners. Spinning World, going to Coolmore, Ireland in 2002, is a very close fourth with 13 winners, and Florida's Outflanker rounds out the top five with 10 winners.

The freshman ranks still have a few noteworthy stories to share. Siphon has six winners and a grade two stakes winner in Siphonic who placed behind Johannesburg and Repent in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1). He also has two stakes-placed performers and his progeny have earned over \$615,000, which is good enough for fourth place on the leading freshman sires' list.

Siphon is a total outcross to North American pedigrees and his start is encouraging. The son of Itajara was a two-time grade one winner in this country and a grade one winner in Brazil. His offspring continue to sell well, as nine of 39 yearlings sold in 2001 have brought \$100,000 or more. He stands at Airdrie Stud in Midway, Kentucky for \$20,000.

Late freshman moves

Alphabet Soup burst onto the freshman sire scene with a successful October. The gray son of Cozzene now has seven winners from 83 foals. He is best remembered for his thrilling win in the 1996 Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) at Woodbine, defeating fellow freshman sire Louis Quatorze and Horse of the Year Cigar. He was an honest runner, winning 10 of 24 starts and hitting the board in 19 of them and went on to earn nearly \$3 million. He stands at Adena Springs Kentucky for \$30,000.

Editor's Note is up to nine winners from a crop of 66 foals. While he has yet to sire a stakes winner, five of his juveniles are stakes-placed. He is yet another son of Forty Niner who is siring early maturing juveniles. Editor's Note was an excellent juvenile in his own right, winning three often starts, including a victory in the Kentucky Cup Juvenile (G3) and a third place finish to Unbridled's Song and Hennessy in that season's Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1). He won the Belmont Stakes (G1) and Super Derby (G1) at three and retired with over \$1.6 million in earnings. He stands at Overbrook Farm in Lexington, Kentucky for \$10,000.

Langfuhr recently sired his ninth juvenile winner and his two-year-olds have earned over \$533,000. His daughter Imperial Gesture has been twice grade one-placed, including a second to likely division champion Tempera in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (G1). The speedy son of Danzig was a tough customer on the race track winning nine and hitting the board in 17 of 23 starts. He was named

Champion Canadian Bred Sprinter in 1996 off of his wins in the Vosburgh Stakes (G1) and Forego Handicap (G2). As a five-year-old he racked up a pair of grade one wins in the Metropolitan Mile and the Carter Handicap. He stands at Vinery in Kentucky for a private fee in 2002.

Happy ending

The overall leader in juvenile winners is End Sweep, with 25 winners, who holds a slim lead over his former barnmate Valid Expectations. Relocated Judge T C, now in Pennsylvania, is keeping the race interesting with 22 winners. Judge T C will stand the 2002 season for \$2,500 at Reigle Heir Farm in Grantville, Pennsylvania.

Another stallion who moves for the 2002 breeding season is Phone Trick, who relocates from Kentucky to New York. Phone Trick has consistently sired early maturing juveniles, including 1997 Champion Two-Year-Old Male and Horse of the Year, Favorite Trick. In 2001, his 16 juvenile winners from 86 equals his career average of 19 percent. He will stand at Milfer Farm for \$25,000 in Unadilla, New York.

Back in Kentucky, Mill Ridge Farm's Gone West is a top juvenile sire in 2001. From a crop of 69 foals he has 17 winners and three grade one/group one winners: Came Home (US), Changeintheweather (Canada), and Saddam (England). Through 10 crops, Gone West produces 18 percent juvenile winners and an impressive 10 percent stakes winners overall. The 17-year-old son of Mr. Prospector is currently in seventh place on the leading sires of juveniles list with over \$843,000 in progeny earnings, and he leads all juvenile sires by juvenile stakes winners with four individual stakes winners in 2001. His fee remains at \$125,000.

Northern babies

Our final stop is north of the border in Canada, where the country's leading juvenile sire battle is still too close to call. The province of British Columbia is where all the action is. Vying Victor has 14 winners, Regal Remark has 12 winners, and Regal Intention with eight winners, lead the field. Regal Remark and Regal Intention are both sons of Canadian star Vice Regent, who is a son of Canada's most famous horse, Northern Dancer.

Vying Victor also has a surprising connection to Vice Regent. The 12-year-old son of Flying Paster is out of the Sir Ivor mare Elegant Victress who's dam Victorian Heiress was by Northern Dancer and out Victoriana, the dam of Vice Regent's dam Victoria Regina. Vying Victor stands for \$5,000 at Ternes Farm in Vancouver, British Columbia. Regal Remark stands at Road's End Farm in Abbotsford for \$3,500 and Regal Intention stands at Canmor Farms in Aldergrove for \$4,000. ☛OB

Rochelle's Shenanigans

First for Private Terms and Elite Broodmare

Private Terms has sired millionaire colts Afternoon Deelites and Soul of the Matter and other graded stakes winning males Connecting Terms and Private Buck Trout, but until recently he had never been represented by a graded stakes winning filly. That changed on November 3, when Rochelle's Terms broke her stakes maiden with a win in the Turnback the Alarm Handicap (G3).

One has to wonder whether Rochelle's Terms' achievement in reversing the apparent sex bias of her sire is down to her extremely clever pedigree. She has Buckpasser 4x4 and Shenanigans 3x4. We're used to seeing Buckpasser inbreeding work, as there are more than 50 unrestricted stakes winners with a double of Buckpasser in the first four generations, including 17 graded stakes winners.

More surprisingly, Rochelle's Terms appears to be the first unrestricted stakes winner with a double of Shenanigans. No superstar on the racetrack – her only black type was earned with a second in the Maryland Futurity – Shenanigans turned out to be a truly outstanding broodmare. In addition to Ruffian, perhaps the greatest filly ever to race in North America, Shenanigans also produced the good runner, and important sire Icecapade, the stakes winner and successful sire, Buckfinder, and sire On to Glory.

Shenanigans is also granddam of Private Terms and other

sires Blue Ensign and Dover Ridge, and third dam of Coronado's Quest. Perhaps we'll soon see some Coronado's Quest stakes winners with Icecapade, Private Terms, Buckfinder, On to Glory or Blue Ensign in the dam.

Three play

Female inbreeding has been a common feature of German breeding for over 100 years, so it is no surprise that Sumitas, German-bred winner of the Knickerbocker Handicap (G2), has some female inbreeding. What is surprising is just how much. Within the first five generations of his pedigree, Sumitas has duplications of three different females, Surama, Love In and Kaiserkrone. On top of this he also has Nijinsky II 3x5 and Neckar 5x5.

There are some very intricate and complex patterns here. Both Lomitas, the sire of Sumitas, and Lagunas, sire of the second dam Sumitas, are bred on a Nijinsky II/Literat cross. What's more, Love In, the third dam of Lomitas, is also granddam of Lagunas. In fact, Lomitas is three-quarters related to Sumitas's granddam, Sumitas.

Volponi's mirror image

Winner of the Pilgrim Stakes (G3) on turf at the end of his juvenile career, Volponi looked to have a promising future on the grass. It took about a year, however, for him to score his next stakes victory, and when it did come, it was on dirt in the Pegasus Handicap (G2). So, perhaps Volponi's future is as a handicap horse on the dirt!

Volponi owns a very cleverly constructed pedigree. He is a son of Cryptoclearance, who was by a son of Mr. Prospector out of a Hoist the Flag mare. Volponi's dam is by the Irish Derby (G1) winner, Sir Harry Lewis, who is bred on a reverse cross to Cryptoclearance, as he is by a son of Hoist the Flag out of a Mr. Prospector mare. Thus, the pedigrees of Cryptoclearance and Sir Harry Lewis are virtual mirror images.

This isn't the first time that a similar pattern has worked for Cryptoclearance. His Kentucky Cup Juvenile Stakes (G3) winner, Laydown, is out of a mare by Forty Niner, a son of Mr. Prospector out of a mare by Hoist the Flag's sire, Tom Rolfe.

We've noticed a considerable number of stakes winners with these "mirror image" or "parallel pattern" pedigrees, where the nick which produced the sire or grandsire is either reproduced or reversed in the dam or the broodmare sire. This probably shouldn't come as a surprise, especially considering sires and broodmare sires, which have generally been decent runners. Logically speaking, inbreeding to a successful cross, rather than just to isolated individuals must surely increase the chance of favorable genes being inherited.

Queue lines up the relatives

A more complex example of "mirror images" and "parallel patterns" is found in the pedigree of the filly Queue, who gained her first graded stakes brackets with a win in the Long Island Handicap (G2).

Queue has a Prince John/Eight Thirty cross through French Deputy's broodmare sire, Hold Your Peace (winner of the Flamingo Stakes and Arlington-Washington Futurity) and her own granddam, Shanghai Mary. Actually, the relationship is even closer than that as Hold Your Peace is by Speak John, whose dam is half-sister to the grandam of Stage Door Johnny, the sire of Shanghai Mary.

The Hold Your Peace/Shanghai Mary connection is only the beginning of the story. When the Bold Ruler mare, Laredo Lass, was sent to Hold Your Peace, the result was French Deputy's dam, Mitterand, winner of four graded stakes including the La Canada Stakes (G1). The reverse was tried with Shanghai Mary, who was bred to What a Pleasure, a son of Bold Ruler, to get Queue's granddam, Peroxide Princess. Eventually, both Mitterand and Peroxide Princess (products of a Bold Ruler/Prince John/Eight Thirty combination) were bred to grandsons of Northern Dancer - Deputy Minister and Baldski respectively - the results being graded stakes winner French Deputy and stakes winner P J Floral, the sire and dam of Queue.

More Than Fantastic

Fantastic Light and Galileo head up new Euro sires

Our English correspondent, Nigel Pullen, has put together an in-depth analysis of the new first season sires entering stud in Europe for 2002. His suggestions for best potential nicks and crosses with these new stallions make for thought-provoking reading, even for breeders not looking to European sources with their mares.

ENGLAND

ARKADIAN HERO (1995 by Trempolino – Careless Kitten by Caro). Longholes Stud, EN. Good sprinter/miler who won the Mill Reef Stakes (G2) at two, and scored two group wins over seven furlongs at five. Trempolino's sire Sharpen Up responds well with duplications of Mixed Marriage, making Known Fact, Lion Cavern, Warning and Zafonic good choices. The Minstrel is a close relative to Trempolino's own maternal grandsire Viceregal, so try Zafonic. Generous, from a similar background as Atan, has already sired Spendent (G3) from Arkadian Hero's family. Arkadian Hero is out of a half sister to the dam of Hennessy, so look for Storm Cat or Storm Bird. Two mares bred on similar lines to Arkadian Hero's granddam are Cap And Bells (dam of Drone) and Spring Adieu (granddam of Danehill). Northern Dancer should also be suitable, especially via Nijinsky II or Dancing Brave.

BERTOLINI (1996 by Danzig – Aquilegia by Alydar). Overbury Stud, EN. Not far behind the best sprinters of his generation, he deserved more than a single pattern race success in the July Stakes (G3) at two. He is a three-quarter brother to Green Desert, who has done well with Ahonoora, High Top, Kris and Shirley Heights. Also consider adding Green Desert's maternal grandsire Sir Ivor or his sire Sir Gaylord. Chief's Crown looks promising, since Bertolini's maternal grandsire Alydar is out of the mare Sweet Tooth, who is very closely related to Chief's Crown's third dam Miss Carmie. Son strains of Never Bend, such as Mill Reef or Riverman would balance the daughter strain of Never Bend already present.

COMPTON ADMIRAL (1996 by Suave Dancer – Sumoto by Mtoto). Hedgeholme Stud, EN. Winner of the Craven (G3) and Eclipse Stakes (G1) at three, beating Haar and Fantastic Light in the latter. He's a half-brother to Summoner (G1), so try his sire Inchinor. Summoner has a double of the mare Miba, so it should be worth seeking out mares from that family. This is also the family of Rockefella (in Sharpen Up) and Danzig.

Suave Dancer hails from the family of Northfields and Habitat, the latter already producing Welney (G2) from Compton Admiral's family. Diesis and Kris have the reverse Relic/Crepello cross to Mtoto. His granddam is by General Assembly, from the family of Exclusive Native and Deputy Minister. The third dam is by Riverman making Mill Reef worthwhile.

FANTASTIC LIGHT (1996 by Rahy – Jood by Nijinsky II). Dalham Hall Stud, EN. Improved each season he raced, won the Hong Kong Cup (G1), Man O'War Stakes (G1) and Prince Of Wales's Stakes (G1), inflicted Galileo's first defeat in the Irish Champion Stakes (G1), and ended with victory in the Breeders Cup Turf (G1). Fantastic Light should appreciate more Northern Dancer, and Nijinsky II, The Minstrel and Caerleon appeal in particular. Devil's Bag is a full brother to Rahy's dam; while Intriguing, the granddam of both Woodman and Private Account, is bred on similar lines to Rahy's third dam Miss Swapsco.

Adding Tom Fool could reinforce the 4x4 cross of the close genetic relatives Spring Run and Flaring Top found in Fantastic Light. His granddam Kamar was a full sister to Love Smitten, the dam of Swain (by Nashwan) and Thief of Hearts (by In the Wings), so look for those two sires or Nashwan's half brother Unfuwain. Kamar was a daughter of Key to the Mint, and the later should act favorably with Alleged. Fantastic Light's 5x5 double of Cohoes would benefit from strains of close genetic relative Never Bend.

GOLDEN SNAKE (1996 by Danzig – Dubian by High Line). National Stud, EN. A four times grade one winner at distances ranging from 1800 to 2400 metres. He is a half brother to 1000 Guineas winner Sayyedati (by Shaded), and useful performer Race Leader (by Gone West). Shaded not only doubles up Northern Dancer, but his dam Continual has a similar background to Dubian. Ela-Mana-Mou has worked well with Danzig, and introduces opposite sex strains of High Hat and Petition. High Line's Hyperion/Chanteur II/Djebel could be reinforced by Blakeney; while Derring-Do picks up many of the strains in Dubian. Golden Snake is from the same family as Sure Blade, who is worth a try because his Needle Gun was out of a mare by High Line. Persian Bold brings in another line of the mare La Diva, as well as Alycidon, bred on the reverse cross as High Hat. Golden Snake's granddam is 3x4 to the mare Sansonnet, so look for more of her half-brother Fair Trial together with Abernant and Forli.

GORSE (1995 by Sharpo – Pervenche by Latest Model). East Burrow Stud, EN. A consistent sprinter, and winner of five group events in Europe. Try adding Known Fact to duplicate the mare Mixed Marriage, and a balancing daughter strain of Sharpen Up could be introduced by using Cadeaux Genereux. Home Guard sired Group winner Mary Guard out of a mare by Latest Model's half brother New Model. Sing Sing is a must, being bred on similar lines to Latest Model's grandsire Pall Mall. Gorse is 4x5x4 to closely related individuals Pretty Swift, Palestine and Propitiation, so add further close genetic relatives to these such as Runnymede, Madrilene (granddam of High Top), Uvira (ancestress of Raja Baba and Wolfhound) and Rain (granddam of Hotfoot). Efisio he has High Top and the good Sharpen Up cross Ribot. Gorse also has strong concentra-

tions of both Quiver and the Lady Juror family, so look to reinforce this using Worden, Wild Risk, Beau Pere, Abernant, Tudor Minstrel or Forli.

MEDICEAN (1997 by Machiavellian – Mystic Goddess by Storm Bird). Cheveley Park Stud, EN. Medicean posted victories in both 2001 Lockinge Stakes (G1, 8f.) and Eclipse Stakes (G1, 10f.). The appearance of Storm Bird makes Nijinsky II and The Minstrel appealing. An especially interesting Nijinsky II source is Kahyasi, since his granddam has the opposite Red God/Sheshoon cross to Medicean's granddam Rose Goddess. Machiavellian has already sired two Group winners from Green Dancer mares, so try them. Medicean comes from the family of Caro, so look for the latter. The dam of Medicean shares a very strong Hurry On/Gainsborough background with the dam of Selkirk, who could be tried.

MUTAMAM (1995 by Darshaan – Petal Girl by Caerleon). National Stud, EN. Lightly raced horse scoring seven Group wins from 10 to 12 furlongs; culminating in the Canadian International (G1). Darshaan has worked extremely well with Sadler's Wells, so try him or Fairy King; while adding Mill Reef's close relative Riverman looks promising. Three of Darshaan's G1 winners have been out of mares by Ajdal; and Arazi and Formidable also come from Ajdal's family. Mutamam's dam is a half sister to Mtoto, so also look out for the latter's sire Busted. Linamix is interesting; his dam has a similar Relic/Alycidon/Persian Gulf cross to Mutamam's granddam. Mutamam's third dam has a similar background to Val de Loir.

OBSERVATORY (1997 by Distant View – Stellaria by Roberto). Banstead Manor Stud, EN. Observatory beat Giant's Causeway in the Queen Elizabeth II Stakes (G1) over a mile and won the Prix d'Ispahan (G1) at four. Observatory is a half-brother to the useful stakes winner Terrestrial (by Theatrical), so Theatrical looks very interesting as he is bred on the opposite sex cross of Northern Dancer/Hail to Reason to Observatory's dam Stellaria. Observatory's granddam Victoria Star is a three-quarter relative to The Minstrel, making him a possible target. Observatory has a concentration of close relatives from the Number 17 family via Johnstown (twice), Black Devil, Flares and Lyphard, so look to add more of those strains. Tom Rolfe's dam Pocahontas has strong links with Roberto's sire Hail to Reason, the latter's strains of Galla Colors and Source Sucre being picked up in Pocahontas by Roman and The Squaw II.

OLDEN TIMES (1998 by Darshaan – Garah by Green Desert). Plantation Stud, EN. Put up his best performance in winning the Prix Jean Prat (G1) over 1800 metres. A son of Darshaan, so duplicating the mare Lalun, through the usual sources such as Fairy King, Sadler's Wells and Mill Reef should pay dividends. Darshaan has also worked well with Caerleon and The Minstrel. Olden Times himself is a three-quarter brother to the dam of Dandoun, so the latter's sire Halling is worth considering. This has the advantage of bringing together the close relatives Kelty and Reliance.

Formidable is by Forli out of Native Partner and thus bred on the reverse cross of Olden Times's dam. Formidable's son Efisio introduces a further strain of Relic, plus Derring-Do, a three-quarter relative to the mare Abella who is found in Olden Times. Efisio also carries High Top, another name to look out for as he is from the same family as Hard Sauce who is found 6x4 in Olden Times. Adjal has worked well with Darshaan and a horse from Ajdal's family with possibilities is Arazi, by Blushing Groom who is from the same family as Olden Time's great grandsire Mill Reef.

PRIMO VALENTINO (1997 by Primo Dominic – Dorothea Brooke by Dancing Brave). Bearstone Stud, EN. Five times winner as a juvenile, culminating with victories in both Mill Reef (G2) and Middle Park Stakes (G1). He also finished fourth in the July Cup (G1) and scored an impressive win in the listed Abernant Stakes. Danzig has a balancing daughter strain of Petition so most of the former's sons and grandsons should work well. Also look out for Forli and Tudor Minstrel, with Efisio and Cadeaux Genereux certainly worth trying. Primo Dominic himself has a similar background to the dam of Desert Style, while his own dam is bred on the same lines to the dam of Cyrano De Bergerac. Primo Valentino's half sister Dora Carrington (G2) was by Sri Pekan, another possibility.

FRANCE

MUNIR (1998 by Indian Ridge – Al Bahathri by Blushing Groom). Le Station D'Etalons, FR. Munir was a seven furlongs winner of the Greenham (G3) and Challenge Stakes (G2), and a son of the Irish 1000 Guineas heroine Al Bahathri. His sire has done very well with Tap On Wood and the latter's sire Sallust. Indian Ridge has also prospered with reinforcement of the Marchetta family, via the mare Rose Red and Sweet Lavender, and with descendants of Friar's Daughter. Since Indian Ridge is 4x4 to the Court Martial mare Discipliner add more relatives of Court Martial such as Petition. Bold Lad (IRE) and Firestreak come from another family which works well with Indian Ridge. Northern Dancer is an obvious choice; Fairy King, Nijinsky II and Sadler's Wells particularly appeal. Dancing Dissident sired Almaty (G3) from Munir's family. Lahib is bred along similar lines to Al Bahathri, and as a bonus his sire Riverman has a background matching that of Munir's fourth dam Generals Sister. General Holme is a three-quarter brother to Munir's granddam, while Munir's third dam is by To Market, so add Roberto whose dam is bred on a very similar pattern.

GERMANY

BANYUMANIK (1996 by Perugino – Bennetta by Top Ville). Gestut Erftmuhle, GER. A three time group winner in Germany from 1600 to 1800 metres. He is sired by Sadler's Wells' three-quarter brother Perugino, so try the proven Sadler's Wells crosses Thatch, Riverman and Mill Reef, the latter's son Shirley Heights also providing a balancing daughter strain of Hardicanute. Acatanango's granddam was a full sister to the third dam of High Top (sire of Top Ville). High Top also makes Busted a possibility, their

dams having similar backgrounds. Lomitas provides Ridan, a full brother to Perugino's third dam Thong. Banyumanik's granddam is by Hard to Beat, and the latter's dam is a three-quarter sister to High Treason. Violin D'Ingres sired Banyumanik's third dam, so try half-brother Luthier.

GREEK DANCE (1995 by Sadler's Wells – Hellenic by Darshaan). Gestut Gorldorf, GER. Sustained an injury after finishing fifth in the Epsom Derby (G1), but returned to score in the Rose Of Lancaster (G3) and Bayerisches Zuchtrennen (G1). He has a similar Sadler's Wells/Shirley Heights cross as In The Wings, who sired top winners out of mares by Diesis, Habitat, Halo, Relkino and Top Ville. This cross doubles the mare Lalun so it could be worth reinforcing via the likes of Riverman or his son Irish River. Or introduce descendants of La Troienne, especially those with Blue Larkspur, as this would give the reverse cross to Lalun's dam be Faithful. Both the sire and dam of Greek Dance trace tail female to the mare Simon's Shoes making other descendants such as Lorenzaccio, Lt. Stevens and Thatch appealing. This is also the family of Reform (a full sister to Greek Dance's fourth dam), whilst another member of this clan is Guineas winner Golan, so Spectrum could be considered.

MORSHDI (1998 by Slip Anchor – Reem Albaraari by Sadler's Wells). Gestut Friedrichsruh, GER. Morshdi won the Derby Italiano (G1) and Grosser Preis von Baden (G1) over 12 furlongs. Slip Anchor comes from a German family, so it should be worthwhile reinforcing this background. Platini has a balancing son of Birkhahn as well as Northfields, a half brother to Habitat (the sire of Morshdi's second dam). Sharpen Up also works well with a German background. Morshdi has the close relatives Never Bend and Bold Reason 4x4; so reinforce this by using Auction Ring or My Babu, the latter found in the German based Big Shuffle. Try adding Habitat's half brother Northfields, as well as more strains from the Rose Red family. Look out for mares from the Picture Play family; they have an affinity for Mill Reef, and Picture Play's dam is bred on very similar lines to the ancestress of Slip Anchor's maternal grandsire Birkhahn.

SILVANO (1996 by Lomitas – Spirit Of Eagles by Beau's Eagle). Gestut Fahrhof, GER. Globetrotting Silvano gained G1 wins over 10 furlongs in America, Hong King and Singapore. Acatenango is an obvious target, as the sire of Silvano's half brother Sabiango (G1), and introduces a balancing son strain of Surumu. Konigsstuhl (or his son Monsun), would double the mare Kaiserkrone. Platini would provide a son of Surumu, and duplicate Northern Dancer, Crepello and Neckar. Lagunas has a similar Nijinsky II/Literat/Love In cross to Lomitas.

Since Lomitas's sire Niniski has Ridan, the latter's full sister Thong should be sought via such as Thatch, Sadler's Wells and Fairy King. Beau's Eagle's granddam is a rare sister to Jet Action, and the latter can be found in Lomond and Seattle Slew. Beau's Eagle also provides Maribeu, a half brother to Halo, whose dam is a half sister to Northern Dancer. Silvano has a similar background of Nijinsky II/Beautiful Spirit to Teggiano (G1), so try her sire Mujtahid or Woodman or Mill Reef.

IRELAND

BECKETT (1998 by Fairy King – Groom Order by Groom Dancer). Tally-Ho Stud, IR. The winner of the National Stakes (G1) at two is from the same family as Exclusive (G1), making her sire Polar Falcon a possibility, by Fairy King's three-quarter brother Nureyev. Another Nureyev of interest is Theatrical, with a balancing daughter of Hail to Reason. The usual suspects for Fairy King including Mill Reef, Riverman, Thatch and Lear Fan should be tried. Machiavellian and his son Vettori also have possibilities. Groom Dancer has worked well with Green Dancer. Lypheor provides balancing strains of Lyphard, Tudor Minstrel, Tourment and Djebel for Groom Dancer, while Kenmare sired Vert Amante (G1) from Groom Dancer's family. Beckett is doubled to Turn-to via sons, so look for daughter strains or balances such as Ambiorix or My Babu.

DISTANT MUSIC (1997 by Distant View – Musicanti by Nijinsky II). Morristown Lattin Stud, IR. Undeclared juvenile and rated second best in Europe after wins in the Champagne (G2) and Dewhurst Stakes (G1), he never recaptured that brilliance but won group races at three and four. Distant View has sired Observatory (G1) from a Roberto mare, so the latter looks an ideal choice. Since Distant Music is 5x2 to Northern Dancer, further strains of him should be avoided, but Mill Reef is a worthwhile alternative. Darius's son Derring-Do has an ideal background to balance Distant View's granddam La Trinite, while Chief Singer hails from Distant View's family. The presence of Nijinsky II suggests adding Blushing Groom. Distant Music's third dam is 4x5 to the mare Gleam, once via Princely Gift, so look for balancing sons of the latter such as Floribunda and King's Leap.

FRUITS OF LOVE (1995 by Hansel – Vallee Secrete by Secretariat). Rathasker Stud, IR. Very tough performer who won back-to-back runnings of the Hardwick Stakes (G2). He is a half brother to Sagamore (by Simply Great) and Mujadil (G3, by Storm Bird) making these two stallions obvious targets. Simply Great was by Mill Reef and the latter's close relative Riverman appears in the pedigree of Hansel's Loving Claim (G1). The Minstrel is a three-quarter relative to Hansel's dam Count On Bonnie. Fruits Of Love has the close relatives Johnstown, Flares and Black Devil, so look to add Flares's full brother Omaha, and Lyphard who traces tail female to the same family. Super Concorde (found in Big Shuffle) is bred on very similar lines to Fruits Of Love's dam. Duplicate the mare Somethingroyal by adding Sir Gaylord or his sons Sir Ivor or Habitat.

GALILEO (1998 by Sadler's Wells – Urban Sea by Miswaki). Coolmore Stud, IR. Gained facile victories in both English and Irish Derby, before beating older horses including Fantastic Light, in the King George V and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (G1). Mill Reef looks an obvious target; he doubles the mare Lalun and has worked well with the German background found in Galileo's granddam. Shirley Heights, Slip Anchor and Darshaan should be good sources.

Other names to work well with Sadler's Wells are Habitat and High Top. Also look to double the mare Thong using Nureyev or Thatch. Vaguely Noble comes from the same family as Lombard (sire of Galileo's granddam) and is sired by Vienna, himself closely related to Espresso (sire of Galileo's third dam). Given the powerful inbreeding behind Galileo's granddam Allegratta, it would be fascinating to duplicate the latter.

GOLAN (1998 by Spectrum – Highland Gift by Generous). Coolmore Stud, IR. Won the English 2,000 Guineas (G1) on only his second start, runner-up in the Epsom Derby and fourth in the Prix de L'Arc de Triomphe. Sadler's Wells and Fairy King have a lot to recommend them. They are bred on a similar Northern Dancer/Hail To Reason cross to Caerleon (sire of Golan's maternal grandsire Generous), come from Golan's female family, and introduce Bold Reason a very close relative to Never Bend (5x5 in Golan). Spectrum's 'niece', the G1 filly Petrushka, was by Unfuwain out of an Ela-Mana-Mou mare, so both those names should be considered.

KALANISI (1996 by Doyoun – Kalamba by Green Dancer). Giltown Stud, IR. He came into his own at four when he won the Queen Anne Stakes (G3), Champion Stakes (G1) and Breeders Cup Turf (G1) from eight to 12 furlongs. Kalanisi is 2x3 to close relatives Mill Reef and Riverman, making Sadler's Wells and Fairy King appeal. They add a further strain of the mare Lalun, and come from the same family as Green Dancer's maternal grandsire Val de Loir. Kalanisi's dam is bred on similar lines to Alhaarth, so the latter's sire Unfuwain or even Nashwan are possibilities. Nasrullah and his full sister Malindi are found in Kalanisi, and this could be further balanced by adding Royal Charger. Ballad Rock is interesting, proving a perfect foil for Kalanisi's third dam with Buisson Ardent and Alycidon to balance Venture VII and Aureole.


KING CHARLEMAGNE (1998 by Nureyev – Race The Wild Wind by Sunny's Halo). Coolmore Stud, IR. Three time group winner over seven furlongs, who put up his best performance by winning the Prix Maurice de Gheest (G1). Being by Nureyev, introducing the latter's close relatives Sadler's Wells and Fairy King is tempting, especially because of the strong build-up of the St. Marguerite family in King Charlemagne. His third dam is by Tim Tam, so this encourages Nijinsky II, Blushing Groom or Sir Ivor to pick up Tim Tam's sire Tom Fool and his Menow/Bull Dog cross. This is the family of Generous, so try him or his sire Caerleon. Riverman has also done well with his family, especially in combination with Hail To Reason, making these two more possible targets.

LEAR SPEAR (1995 by Lear Fan – Golden Gorse by His Majesty). Rathbarry Stud, IR. Lear Spear gained his most prestigious win in the Prince Of Wales's Stakes (G2), when he defeated Fantastic Light and Xaar. Lear Spear is free of Northern Dancer, and Lear Fan has done well with Nureyev, so look for him, as well as introducing the mare Thong via Thatch, Sadler's Wells and Fairy King. Wolfhound is an

especially interesting son of Nureyev since his dam has a similar Buckpasser/Sir Gaylord cross to Lear Spear's third dam. Lear Fan's dam is a full sister to Alysheba making him a possible along with his sire Alydar. Duplicating Buckpasser should be worthwhile especially as Lear Fan's granddam has a similar background to him. His Majesty is a full brother to Graustark, and seek out close relatives of their dam Flower Bed, such as Swaps and Determine. Warning provides a balancing daughter of Roberto.

MOZART (1998 by Danehill – Victoria Cross by Spectacular Bid). Coolmore Stud, IR. After a second in the Irish 2000, Mozart was reverted to sprinting with devastating results, running away with July Cup (G1) and Nunthorpe Stakes (G1). His pedigree has four real 'hot-spots'; 3x3 to full brothers His Majesty/Graustark (by Ribot – Flower Bowl); 5x4 to War Admiral/La Troienne sources Busanda/Searching; a sire 3x3 to Natalma via Northern Dancer and Spring Adieu, and a maternal grandsire 3x3 To Market. Adding Princequillo (similar background to Ribot) and Flower Bowl's close relatives Swaps, Determine and Lurline B (in Damister, sire of Celtic Swing) could reinforce the His Majesty/Graustark combination. Woodman and Private Account would prove ideal foils for Busanda/Searching. Caerleon is also from the La Troienne family, doubles Hail to Reason, and also has Northern Dancer who should also be sought. To Market's maternal grandsire Johnstown has a number of close relatives to look out for including Omaha, Flares and Black Devil.

MULL OF KINTYRE (1997 by Danzig – Retrospective by Easy Goer) Coolmore Stud, IR. Winner of the Gimcrack Stakes (G2) and a fine fourth in the Breeders Cup Juvenile (G1), before injury. He returned at four to finish a close second to King Charlemagne in the Minstrel Stakes (G3). Look to add Danzig favorites Buckpasser, Ribot and Turn-to, who already appear in Mull of Kintyre's dam. Rockefeller is always welcomed by Danzig. Easy Goer's dam is doubled to La Troienne; so further concentrations of that must be worthwhile. Mull of Kintyre's granddam is by Hoist the Flag, so balance this with a son strain, for instance using Alleged. She is also the dam of Broad Brush, making the latter a possible together with his sire Ack Ack.

SUNSHINE STREET (1995 by Sunshine Forever – Meadow Spirit by Chief's Crown). Bluegate Stud, IR. Ran the race of his life to finish fourth in the Epsom Derby and gained a deserved Grade 1 success when taking the San Juan Capistrano Handicap at Santa Anita at five. Sunshine Street is 3x3 to Graustark with a strain of Swaps, who is a three quarter brother to Graustark's dam. Another variation of this Alibhai/Beau Pere cross is found in Honey's Alibi and also Lurline B (present in Damister). Since Beau Pere was 3x3 to the mare Quiver, it could be worth looking for Right Royal V, Wild Risk and Worden to reinforce this. Mr. Prospector should work well with Sunshine Forever's sire Roberto, while Alydar looks an ideal foil for Chief's Crown.

Nureyev Remembered

The life and influence of one of our great sires

"We were distinctly fortunate to have Nureyev around for as long as we did."

You know you are getting old when distant events seem distinctly recent in the memory, and realization of the advancing years was one of the principal effects that hearing of Nureyev's death had on me. It seems only a few years since I was a track meeting at Maidenhead, in Berkshire, England - attempting the rather bizarre double of 400m. hurdles and 3000m. steeplechase - and in between listening to Nureyev come from last to first to catch Known Fact in the 2,000 Guineas (G1), only to be disqualified.

I remember, equally clearly, getting the word on the "grapevine" that illness would cause then ante-post favorite Nureyev to miss the Epsom Derby, and rushing to back the then second favorite, and eventual winner, Henbit, before his odds decreased.

Whatever tricks the memory may play, the reality of it is that it is 21 years since Nureyev last faced the starter, and the son of Northern Dancer had reached the age of 24 when cancer of the foot forced the decision to euthanize him on October 29. Actually, we were distinctly fortunate to have Nureyev around for as long as we did. He suffered a fracture to his right hind leg during the 1987 breeding season, and was initially given only a 10 percent chance of survival, but remarkably he recovered quickly enough to return to the breeding shed the following year.

A seven figure Dancer

A member of the twelfth crop sired by Northern Dancer, Nureyev, was the third foal of his dam, Special (her previous foal was Fairy Bridge, subsequently dam of Nureyev's three-parts-brothers Sadler's Wells and Fairy King). Nureyev was purchased for \$1,300,000 by the British Bloodstock Agency on behalf of Stavros Niarchos at the 1978 Keeneland July Yearling Sales, that venue's top priced lot. Trained by Francois Boutin, he won the Prix Thomas Bryon (G3) by six lengths on his only start at two. He captured the Prix Djebel on his reappearance at three, and his only other start was his ill-fated run in the 2,000 Guineas (G1).

Nureyev retired to stand at the Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard for the 1981 season (he also had one foal from a test crop sired the previous year), but stood just one year in France before being purchased by John T. L. Jones, Jr. who brought him to Kentucky, and syndicated him for a value of over \$14,000,000. Standing at the farm known as Walmac-Warnerton Farm and then later as Walmac International, Nureyev proved to be one of the most important sires of his era.

To date, from 19 crops, totaling 729 foals, Nureyev has sired 130 stakes winners. This gives him a remarkable 18 percent stakes winners to foals, a figure places him second only to Danzig at the top of the table for Leading Sires by Percent of Stakes Winners. By lifetime stakes winners, Nureyev ranks seventh on the all time list, behind Sadler's Wells, Mr. Prospector, Danzig, Danehill, Nijinsky II and Northern Dancer. Nureyev is also broodmare sire of 96

stakes winners. He took the French Sires Championship twice, and among his 23 champions are Miesque, Theatrical, Spinning World, Peintre Celebre, Sonic Lady, Soviet Star, Fasliyev and Zilzal.

The next generation


Nureyev has not been a true sire of sires in the sense of being responsible for a number of dominant sires. However, more than 30 sons of Nureyev have sired stakes winners, more than 20 have sired graded stakes winners, and at least 11 have sired group or grade one winners.

The star has been Theatrical, a physically untypical son of Nureyev, who earned Champion Turf Horse honors at the age of five, and who has since gone on to earn recognition as an outstanding international turf sire. Others of note are Robin des Bois, who started well in Argentina, before dying young (Robin des Bois' son, Gentlemen, continues the Nureyev legacy at Walmac); Polar Falcon, who has been a solid sire in England, and who has a very promising young son in the shape of Pivotal; Soviet Star and Zilzal.

Two of Nureyev's most talented sons, the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (G1) and French Derby (G1) winner Peintre Celebre, and Juvenile Champion, Fasliyev, are still only in the early stages of their careers. Peintre Celebre's Northern Hemisphere crop are two-year-olds of 2002, and Fasliyev's first crop arrived this year. Nureyev's group one winning son King Charlemagne will retire to stud this year, and the grade one winning Skimming is still in training.

Even better daughters

Nureyev is already broodmare sire of two extremely important sires in the outstanding New Zealand stallion, Zabeel, and in Kingmambo (out of Nureyev's brilliant daughter Miesque). Other sires out of Nureyev mares including Kingmambo's brother, Miesque's Son; the deceased Peteski; Desert King, a stakes sire with his first crop this year; and a pair yet to have runners, Loup Sauvage and Fantastic Fellow.

There has already been a group one winner with Nureyev inbreeding in the shape of Silvester Lady, heroine of the 2000 German Oaks (G1). She is by Nureyev's grandson, Pivotal, out of a mare by Nureyev's son, Soviet Star. We have also already seen the combination of Nureyev and his three-parts-brother Sadler's Wells in Champion El Condor Pasa and group winners La Sylphide and Wellbeing.
