1 MILE. (Turf) (1:31²) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 Appleton S.FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, March 20. \$2,000 to enter and \$1,000 to start, with all starters to receive a \$1,000 rebate in addition to the purse. \$200,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake on the turf since October 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes on the turf since October 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile). (Cloudy 86)

Dark Bay or Brown Gelding, (Mar), by Circular Quay - Classic Beauty by Sword Dance (IRE). Trainer Brendan P. Walsh. Bred by Gilbert G. Campbell (FL).

REPORTING STAR raced along the outside under a snug hold in the first turn, continued rated just off the top two leaders in the early backstretch, inched up closer leaving the half mile marker, set sights on the top two leaders three furlongs out, kept on patiently nearing the final turn, came under a strong ride at the furlong marker, responded gamely, dueled with FORCED THE PASS in final stages and dug in gamely to hold on. DIVISIDERO was allowed to settle back off the pace in early stages, edged up closer midway through the backstretch, given cue at the quarter pole, came out four wide at head of the lane, moved up within striking distance then drifted out late and captured place at the wire. FORCE THE PASS pulled just off the early leader then moved up to engage rival after the half, dueled for the lead in the far turn, took on added challengers, fought off foes, led the way then took on the late bid of eventual winner, dueled gamely but could not hold on then lost place at the wire. SKY CAPTAIN raced back off pace running through the backstretch, showed response racing between rivals turning for home, continued urging a couple paths off the inside and had mild improve. LONG ON VALUE broke in and brushed rival at the start, took the lead and set the pace in the early backstretch, challenged by FORCED THE PASS after the half mile, dueled in the far turn, could not keep up the pace in late stages and gawaway. WITH EXULTATION was allowed to settle back off the early pace, saved ground racing along the inside, angled out three wide in the far turn, continued with response into the lane then came up empty and flattened out. AKTABANTAY (GB) was squeezed back at the start, raced in the back of the pack and failed to move on when asked. ALL INCLUDED settled midpack while saving ground tucked in along the inside, continued with good response three furlongs out, drifted out in the lane, urged right handed and gawaway.
