For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,250 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. WHITE FLAG saw the rider grab hold shying momentarily from FIELDER after the field had been sent on its way, moved inward, eventually taking up residence in the two path, stalked the front runners, firmly rated, picked up interest tipping to the outside in preparation for the drive home, approaching the five-sixteenths marker, making his way into the four path by the conclusion of the maneuver, settled in and was given his cue, responded energetically, emerging at the eighth pole narrowly in front, dug in with good determination to stay in the clear. DISCO PARTNER guded over to the inside by the end of the backstretch, sat reserved bidding time during the run around the bend, was put to a ride getting sent to the outside as the half was being completed, wound up in path five, came home with good energy down the center of the course but fell short. KITTEN'S CAT kept watch on the front runners while stationed in the pocket, all done without the benefit of being covered up by either one of them, got roused cutting the corner into the lane with sufficient room along the inside corridor with which to launch a rally, inched up to loom boldly by the beginning of the last eighth only to flatten out somewhat. HEMBREE remained on the inside route after the start, was sighted loping along for nearly a half, was under a left whip getting worked out into path six from upper to midstretch, straightened away, rallied with belated energy for the last major check. BLIND AMBITION pressed the issue three wide for the opening half, got set down spinning into the lane, kept up the fight for a little while longer before giving way. DUBINI hustled from the gate, grabbed the advantage, showed the way from path two, prompted by BLIND AMBITION to the outside, felt an uptick in pressure as the second fraction was about to posted on the board, got turned loose in response, was collared at the furlong grounds then steadily weakened. FIELDER came out slightly at the start, was three wide entering the turn and fanned out into path seven after departing it, lacked the needed response.
