Dark Bay or Brown Mare, (Mar), by Indian Charlie - By the Light by Malibu Moon. Trainer Michelle Nevin. Bred by Samantha Siegel (KY).
 BY THE MOON ended up with command shortly after the start as none of her rivals seemed interested in committing to that position and showed the way rated in the two path briefly giving PAULASSILVERLINING the space to advanced before tucking inside with five furlongs to go and shutting down that option, remained on hold through sensible splits awaiting a challenge through to the midway point on the turn, came under pressure for the initial time by HIGHWAY STAR and was placed to coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner into upper stretch under threat, dug in under a drive as her main danger latched on nearing the eighth pole, fought head to head through the final sixteenth and prevailed gamely at the finish keeping her head in front to the wire. HIGHWAY STAR two to three wide in aim of the leader in hand, tucked to the two path through the turn advancing to pressure the aforementioned foe at the midway point on the turn, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside for home, dug in under a drive latching on and shied from a near sided stick a furlong out and once more nearing the sixteenth marker, battled head to head gamely through to the finish but was ultimately bested at the end. CARINA MIA two to three wide in hand in range of the leader, tipped out three wide nearing the three-eighths when CURLIN'S APPROVAL got out and nudged DISTINTA to the four path put to coaxing inside that station to open a clear path, swung three wide at the quarter pole, rallied to threaten through the final eighth but did not have enough to get by the top pair chasing them home to the finish while clear for the show honors. BIRDATTHEWIRE just off the inside at the tail of the compact field, tucked inside half a mile from home before angling back to the two path placed to urging three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, kept on to be along for the last major share. PAULASSILVERLINING broke well and came under rating tucking inside after the start, had a brief chance to advance inside of BY THE MOON as that rival showed the way from the two path and passed on it allowing that foe to shut down the inside with five furlongs to go, settled in hand in the pocket using the cover of that rival on hold until put to coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, angled out a path nearing the eighth pole and came up empty. CURLIN'S APPROVAL a bit fractious prior to the start, chased just off the inside just off the pace under a firm hold, got out nearing the three-eighths to be three to four wide despite a corrective off side stick, continued four wide at the head of the stretch and weakened. DISTINTA three wide in the clear on the outside of the tight knit field, pulled on the bit near the five-eighths growing briefly keen and wanting to go, remained on hold into the turn and got nudged four wide at the three-eighths by CARINA MIA wanting to take over the three path when put to urging, cornered three wide a the top of the stretch and weakened in the drive.
