

a second time, was allowed to wander into the seven path during the ensuing furlong, finally securing the coveted clear path to the wire by the

completion of the maneunver, kicked into her best stride and charged down the outside of the course with sharp speed, nailing TEPIN in the last

jump to prove best. TEPIN the early leader, was overtaken by KITTEN'S QUEEN, tipped into the two path after being displaced on the front end, was patiently handled keeping an eye on the leader, followed the previously-named oppoinent outward as the field spun into the stretch, wound

up challenging three wide at the top of the lane, fought her way to a slim advantage, dug in gamely only to get reeled in right at the finish line. MY MISS SOPHIA tracked the pacesetter from along the inside route, gained sufficient clearance along the hedge once KITTEN'S QUEEN began to drift into the two path heeding home, responded willingly when given its cue, loomed boldly at the eighth pole, made up no additional real estate thereafter and had to settle for the show. KITTEN'S QUEEN took charge using her own power during the straight run leading up to the clubhouse

turn, cut over closer to the rail, got rated showing the way, placed at a slight distatnce from off the hedge, drifted into the two path entering the turn, held out until midstretch before releasing the lead for good. COFFEE CLIQUE parked out three wide on each bend, launched a run when let out a notch at the three-eighths pole, kept up the momentum until maknig her way to the furlong grounds before flattening out. SOLID APPEAL exchanged some light bumpe with the eventual winner a few strides after the start, raced towards the inside, shifted into the eight path from upper to midstretch, made no impact.
