LADY ELI away in good order, got set up in the two path heading for the clubhouse bend, swung three wide onto the backstretch, loosely behind ANTONOE before re-tucknig back into the two path at the seven-sixteenths marker, was forced to be kept on hold, caught behind some rivals beginning with the last few jumps of the run around the far turn, inched her way to the outside, rubbed shoulders with ON LEAVE being given her cue at the three-sixteenths pole, having both secured path three and therefore the freedom to launch her rally, closed in readily, took over with slightly under an eighth remaining, was expertly guided over nearer to the inside leaving the eighth pole for a better look at the nemesis, intermittently fed right side stick work, but with the pilot also being good enough to apply strong pressure on the right rein too to prevent any contact between them, won the duel with DICKINSON in the final sixteenth to clearly prove best. DICKINSON off to a sharp beginning, quickly established control, cut over to the inside, showed the way, pulling slightly on the left, was at first attended by ANTONOE to her outside, saw ON LEAVE take up the role of primary pursuer after the half had been completed, was still engaged with that foe heading into the stretch, staved off the challenger, but gained no respite, what with the eventual winner, now in the clear and fully-revved up, bearing down to her right, put up a good fight before getting collared a short distance beyond the furlong marker. ROCA ROJO (IRE) got checked after lumbering her way out of the gate, was dragged by the rider over to the hedge, loped along as the trailer for six furlongs, saving ground and pulling hard on the left side of the bit, responded with a display of acceleration when given her cue leaving the five-sixteenths pole, angled six wide into the stretch, straightened away and came home with solid, but belatedly energy. ANTONOE stalked the leader two to three wide on the clubhouse bend, moved into a snugger fit on the three path shortly after entering the backstretch, tried to keep ON LEAVE hemmed in behind her, but failed, even after coming in slightly and initiating contact with her, travelled three wide on the far turn, got asked for more after going six furlongs, stepped into the stretch and gave way. ON LEAVE chased DICKINSON towards the two path during the early going, patiently kept watch on that rival to midway on the backstretch, picked it up and split rivals to apply pressure of her own after the second split had been recorded, out-muscling ANTONOE'S attempt to prevent it, pressed the issue on the second bend, bid in earnest heading home, brushed with LADY ELI as that one was in the final stages of settling into the three path in upper stretch, got turned back and faltered.
