6 FURLONGS. (1:07²) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Bashford Manor S. (Grade III) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$2,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Colts and Geldings 122 lbs. Fillies 119 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming, allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Bashford Manor will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights with consideration to the sex allowance. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 16, 2018 with 25 nominations. (Clear 91)

Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by More Than Ready - Kivi by King of Kings (IRE). Trainer Steven M. Asmussen. Bred by Two Stamp stables (KY).

SIR TRUEBADOUR was bumped at the start, set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn, drew clear down the lane and held sway in the final stages. MR CHOCOLATE CHIP broke awkwardly at the start and raced back early, fanned into the five path in the turn, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. OVERANALYZER was unhurried early, shifted into the three path in the turn, rallied in the stretch from the inside with a late gain in the final stages. CAT ADDICTION was bothered at the start and raced back early, swung into the six path in the turn with a late rally in the stretch run. WEILAND came out at the start, tracked the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. THE SONG OF JOHN pressed the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. DALLIANCE stalked the pace early, fanned into the seven path in the turn and faded down the lane. SHANGHAIED ROO chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn, came out and bumped foe in the stretch and faded late in the drive. BAYTOWN GLORY broke slowly from the gate and was no threat. TOOTHLESS WONDER was bumped and bothered in the stretch. EYE CLOUD steadied in the turn and was vanned off after the race. MR. GRANITE had brief speed then folded up.
