By subscription of \$400 each which should accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Weight for age. Three-year-olds. 120 lbs.; older, 123 lbs. Mrs. John E. Cowdin has donated a perpetual cup to be held by the owner of the winner for one year. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday September 12, 2015 with 12 Nominations. (Clear 70)

WEDDING TOAST broke out at the start and was corrected, got lightly coaxed early before settling in hand inside showing the way down the backstretch, remained confidently and patiently handled awaiting a challenge through the turn, cut the corner into upper stretch shaking away from the field, had the rider sneak a peek back and was roused a furlong from home, drifted out three paths under a vigorous hand ride holding clear to the wire to prevail comfortably. CURALINA stumbled at the start getting away last, ranged up to track WEDDING TOAST from the pocket, rode the pocket in reserve until tipped to the two path five-sixteenths from home, continued just off the inside into upper stretch under a drive, chased the winner home offering up a mild kick to cut into the margin slightly while clear of the rest and second best on this day. CATCH MY DRIFT in a bit tight between foes at the start due to pressure from HOT STONES recocering outwards from losing her footing at the start, saved ground early on, tipped three to four wide three furlongs out put to urging and bid three to four wide through the latter portion of the turn advancing to striking range continuing three to four wide for home, couldn't sustain the move nearing the eighth pole and weakened through the final eighth while clear for the show honors. CALL PAT three then two wide in pursuit, lost position into the turn and came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining in response, chased just off the inside through the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. HOUSE RULES settled four wide near the rear, tucked three wide through the turn coming under a ride five-sixteenths out, angled five wide at the quarter pole and tired. HOT STONES lost her footing at the start recovering outwards which put CATCH MY DRIFT in tight between foes briefly, attended the pace of WEDDING TOAST in hand three then two wide, came under urging past the five-sixteenths, faded swinging three wide at the quarter pole and faltered in the drive.
