1¹/₈ MILE. (Inner Turf) (2:13) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 Bowling Green H.INNER TURF FOR FOUR- YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$250 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weights, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 twice at a mile or over in 2014-15 allowed 2 lbs.; of one such race in 2014-15 allowed 4 lbs.; of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2014-15 allowed, 6 lbs.; of one such race in 2014-15, allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 18, 2015 with 40 Nominations. (Rail at 9 feet). (Clear 80)

Chestnut Gelding, (Apr), by Giant's Causeway - May Night by Gulch. Trainer Todd A. Pletcher. Bred by Twin Creeks Farm, Tom Clark & Nancy Clark (KY).

RED RIFLE dropped back along the rail into the first turn, settled on the inside, saved ground while patiently ridden through the final turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, eased off the rail in upper stretch, split horses to make a bid near the eighth-pole, was put to a drive after gaining the lead, kicked clear into the final sixteenth under a right-handed whip and proved best under a strong hand ride late in an excellent ride. WAR DANCER was rated on the inside while tugging at the bit, drafted behind the leader on the final turn, slipped off the rail then was asked outside the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, made an outside bid at the three-sixteenths, battled on the outside of three opponents into the final furlong and was outfinished then was eased up late while safely securing the place. IMAGINING dropped back early, raced inside on the first turn, moved out after turning down the stretch for the first time, made a very early move with seven-eighths to run, was caught four wide on the second turn, tracked the leader down the backstretch, ranged up three wide to make a bid on the final turn, came under a drive turning into the stretch, battled between horses into the final furlong and weakened while clear for the show. IRON POWER set a joint pace on the inside, inched clear with a half-mile to run, came under urging when challenged on the final turn, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and tired. MORNING CALM set a joint pace on the outside while racing in the two path, dropped back a bit under some urging with a half-mile to run, fell further back in the two path on the final turn and capitulated. GOLDEN SOUL raced in the two path on the first turn, settled outside down the stretch for the first time, went three wide on the second turn, continued outside on the backstretch, came under urging while two to three wide on the final turn and failed to respond. AL KHALI was caught four wide on the first turn, raced off the pace while under restraint, went three wide on the second turn, settled on the backstretch, was roused while three wide on the final turn and also failed to respond. DRAMEDY bumped with INNOVATION ECONOMY after start, raced in the three path while off heels on the first turn, was rated just off the pace while a bit eager, went around the second turn in the two path, dropped back onto the backstretch, fell to the rear of the field and came up empty. INNOVATION ECONOMY bumped with DRAMEDY after the start, was unhurried while off the rail through the second turn, broke down inside the five-eighths pole then was humanely euthanized. (Rail at 9 Feet)
