1 1/2 MILE. (2:24) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 Brooklyn Invitational S. AN INVITATIONAL FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The purse to be divided as follows \$220,000 to the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth and \$8,000 to sixth with the remaining \$8,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One race at a mile or over in 2016-2017 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade Two race at a mile or over in 2016-17, 4 lbs.; a Grade Three race at a mile or over in 2016-17, 6 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2017, 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 83)

WAR STORY off the inside throughout, got guided into the two path before reaching the top of the first turn, stalked the leader from afar for nearly three-quarters, tipped out into path four at the half mile and got put to a drive, paused at the five-sixteenths pole, then moved farther to the outside rather than attempting to split opponents at that station, swung five wide into the stretch and took off in earnest after the front runners, out-worked them and struck the front with slightly under a furlong to go, edged clear, kept to the task at hand. SUNNY RIDGE set up in three path coming to the end of the homestretch, continued at a considerable distance off the rail along the backstretch, entered the far turn five wide and ranged up to press the leader, forged to a narrow lead late on the second bend, had the winner draw up to issue his challenge after settling into upper stretch, got reeled in a short distance beyond the eighth pole, vied willingly for the next sixteenth before backing away. TU BRUTUS (CHI) away well, quickly established control, carved out the pace stationed out in path three, felt an uptick in pressure nearing the conclusion of the backstretch, had SUNNY RIDGE force the issue to his outside soon after stepping onto the far turn, was head to head with that foe sliding over closer to the rail at the five-sixteenths marker, wound up about a half length behind when called upon for the stretch, stayed prominently placed for the ensuing furlong before weakening into the show slot. GOVERNOR MALIBU along the inside route proceeding along the homestretch, got eased out into path two after entering the clubhouse bend, sat in midpack pursuing TU BRUTUS, had the rider resort to a brisk hand ride nearing the half mile pole, went over towards the rail leaving the three-eighths pole, was under a full drive cutting the corner into the stretch, made no impact. DOYOUKNOWSOMETHING mostly four wide on each turn, got set down taking path five into the stretch, had no gain. BEHESHT (FR) travelled in the three path on the first turn, shifted closer to the rail once onto the backstretch, departed it still placed in path two, stepped three wide into the stretch and went about towards the finish line in hand. Note none in this field of six spend significant time along the inside route from the opening turn to the five-sixteenths pole.
