Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by First Dude - Aidan by Dixieland Band. Trainer Marialice Coffey. Bred by Dizney Double Diamond LLC (FL).

FLORA DORA coaxed from the start, saved ground tracking in range, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied outside the lead pair closing determined to latch on a sixteenth out, went by in the final strides to score inching away at the end. SCATOOSH four then three wide through the first turn, attended the pace three then two wide, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide for home and seized narrow command three-sixteenths out, dug in under a drive fending off the former leader to the inside and shaking that one off a sixteenth out when confronted by the aforementioned foe, tussled briefly before collared in the last jumps to the finish. LOST RAVEN hustled from the gate, showed the way along the inside in hand under attendance from SCATOOSH to the outside through sensible splits, came under urging as that escort upped the pressure five-sixteenths out, swung just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in and was headed three-sixteenths from home, ran on latched on to the sixteenth marker before weakening late on while well clear of the rest for the show. DREAMS TO REALITY three wide through the first turn forwardly placed, settled just off the inside between foes unhurried and lost position through the run down the backstretch while patiently handled retreating to the rear by midway on the turn, came under urging five-sixteenths out, swung three wide for home and improved position by tired foes while gaining no ground on the front. SHE'S SO FINE three wide through the first turn, raced four then three wide near the rear coming under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home, angled six wide at the head of the stretch, tired in the drive. ALTO BELLE stumbled at the start, raced two to three wide through the first turn, settled in mid pack down the backstretch, tucked to the rail half a mile from home then came under urging seven-sixteenths out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. INVITE three to four wide through the first turn, advanced four to five wide midway down the backstretch to be in range of the front into the far turn, came under urging three furlongs out, faded through the latter portion nearing the quarter pole, swung five wide at that station and faltered in the stretch. ARCH OR NOTHING stumbled badly at the start pecking her face to the ground and lost the rider. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the start focusing on ARCH OR NOTHING before the race was declared official.
