The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 2% to fifth, 1% to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth. Weight: Three-Year-Olds, 121 lbs. Older, 126 lbs. Fillies and Mares, 3 lbs. allowance. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) Final entries to be made through the entry box by 10:30 a.m. Wednesday October 10, 2018. Supplementary nominations may be made no later than the time of final entry by of a non-refundable fee of \$16,000, which shall include the entry fee. \*Preference for this race will be given in the following order. First Preference to Graded/Group winners in 2017/2018. Second Preference to Graded/Group earnings achieved in 2017/2018. Third Preference to total lifetime earnings. DESERT ENCOUNTER (IRE) was off slowly, found the rail quickly while settling near the back, remained unhurried down the backstretch, was just off of the rail racing two-wide on the far turn, trailed the field turning into the stretch, lacked room past the 1/4 pole, angled out nearing the 3/16ths pole, launched a rally and made the lead while lugging inwards. THUNDERING BLUE took a bump from KHAN at the start, was unhurried in the early stages, saved ground, improved to meet the pack midway down the backstretch, came off of the rail at the 5/16ths but was blocked into early stretch, found room at the 3/16ths pole, surged to the front but was outfinished by DESERT ENCOUNTER and checked through the wire as that foe forced him inwards. FOCUS GROUP trailed the field in the early stages, saved ground, commenced a rally at the 3/8ths pole while angling off of the rail, swung six-wide into the stretch and closed gamely down the outside. TIZ A SLAM showed speed, duelled briefly approaching the opening turn, took back to stalk the leaders, began to press while racing two-wide on the far turn, made another bid for the lead and duelled in the stretch, had the advantage briefly in midstretch but tired late. SPRING QUALITY was unhurried early, raced two-wide on the clubhouse turn, advanced into midpack down the backstretch, stalked the leaders while racing four-wide on the far turn, was in range in early stretch but lacked late kick. MARKITOFF raced in midpack while saving ground early, advanced to stalk into the far turn where he raced two-wide between foes, was in range in early stretch but flattened out. JOHNNY BEAR raced widest of all early in midpack, advanced to stalk the leaders down the backstretch, raced three-wide between foes on the far turn and was in range in early stretch but evened out. BANDUA showed early speed, was hustled to the lead entering the opening turn, set the pace down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, was headed in early stretch and duelled but gave way midway down the lane. ENGLISH ILLUSION raced near the back, was two-wide on the opening turn, entered the far turn racing three-wide, began to improve past the 3/8ths pole, angled out entering the stretch but failed to sustain his bid. KHAN (GER) bumped into THUNDERING BLUE at the start, stalked the pace early while racing two-wide, dropped into midpack, was ridden on the far turn but offered no response and was empty in the stretch. FUNTASTIC duelled for the early lead, took back to stalk as BANDUA rushed past, saved ground on the far turn and came up empty in the stretch.
